Subject: **Diversion of 0.2646 hac of forest land in favour of HPSEB Ltd. for the construction of 33/11KV 2X1.6MVA Un-manned Sub-Station Raison at Raugi Nalla within the jurisdiction Kullu Forest Division Kullu.**

Sir,

It is submitted that the Sr. Executive Engineer, Electrical Division HPSEBL. Manali Distt. Kullu, vide their office letter No. HPSEBL/EDM/SI-Scheme/2019-20/3551-52 dt. 14.10.2019 has applied for issue of distance certificate from the nearest Protected Area.

In this connection, it is submitted that the proposed site for construction of 33/KV 2X1.6MVA Un-manned Sub-Station Raison at Raugi Nalla, does not fall within the boundary of Kais & Manali Wild Life Sanctuaries as well as its proposed Eco-Sensitive Zones. The aerial distance from Kais & Manali Wild Life Sanctuaries & its Eco-Sensitive Zones is as under:-

The distance from the Wild Life Sanctuary Kais is less than 10 Km and if the proposed Un-manned Sub-Station is constructed, there will be no direct impact/ disturbance to Flora and Fauna and of the Kais Wild Life Sanctuary.

There is no specific Wild animal passage recorded in the above said area and in view of above that there is no requirement of Animal Passage Plan for the proposed Un-manned Sub-Station Raison.
