


TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment of Forests (MoEF) , Government of India Lr no 11-9/98-FC(Pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Schedule tribes and other traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ("FRA", for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for Non forest purposes read with MoEF letter Dated 05th Feb'2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of Linear projects, it is certified that 0.624 Ha of forest land to be diverted in favour of Regional Officer, MORTH in respect of the work "Construction of Six Lane Elevated Corridor from Km 7.950 to km 14.200 of NH-163 to decongest the urban limits of Hyderabad-Bhoopalapatnam Section on EPC Mode in the state of Telangana" which falls in Narapally forest block, Medipally mandal in Medchal-Malkajgiri District.

It is further certified that

- The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for a entire 0.624 Ha of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meeting of forest rights committee(s), Sub - Divisional level Committee and the District level Committee are enclosed.
- The Diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA has been completed in the Sub-Divisional Committee's has given their consent to it.
- The proposal does not involve recognized rights of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre Agricultural Communities.
