PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF MYSORE.

ORDER No. AFD. 420 FGL 70, DATED, BANGALORE, THE 2nd March 1972.

Read:- 1) Repn. dated 19/10/70 of Swami Nirmalananda.
2) Letter No. B3/GFL/2031/66-67, dated 17-1-72
of the Chief Conservator of Forests (Gnl.),
Bangalore.

PREAMBLE:

In his representation dated 19-10-1970 (cited (1) above, Swami Nirmalananda has represented for grant permanently of one acre of land in B.R.T. Hills held by him on lease for starting an Ashram.

(ii) The Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter dated 17-1-1972 cited (2) above, has reported ~~that he is in favour of granting the land permanently.~~

Government consider the case sympathetically and decide to ~~grant~~ lease the land for 2 years in the first instance.

ORDER

Sanction is accorded to extension of the lease of one Acre of land in B.R.T. Hills, Chamarajanagar Taluk, Mysore District to Swami Nirmalananda for an Ashram for a period of 2 years only, subject to the usual terms and conditions attached to the original lease. The Chief Conservator of Forests should fix the amount of Annual Rent and recover it from the Swamiji from the date Swamiji has occupied the land.

The Chief Conservator of Forests is directed to take further action in the matter.
