- ii. Your furnishing of a certificate under Article 293(1) of the Constitution of India 10 the effect that the borrowings do not exceed the borrowing power, if any, stipulated by the State Legislature and consent of Government of India under article 293(3) of the Constitution of India as per Form-1.
- iii (a). The mobilisation advance will be available on acceptance of terms and conditions of sanction accorded by NABARD. However, if implementation of the project is not initiated by issuing necessary work orders etc., within twelve months from the date of sanction letter, the mobilisation advance shall be recalled and for adjusted towards release of loans in other projects.
- iii (b). If the State Government fails to initiate the implementation of the project by issue of necessary work orders etc., within a period of eighteen months from the date of the sanction letter, the sanction of the project for RIDF assistance shall lapse.
- iii (c).
