**SITE INSPECTION REPORT BY AN OFFICER NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF/DFO

01. A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, R & B Division, Kupwara for diversion under FCA, 1980 of 0.175 Hac of Forest Land in compitt. 01/NL for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Construction of Parallel bypass road from Old Bridge Kupwara upto Steel Bridge Kupwara. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on **13.11.2021**. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest land measuring 0.175 Hac. The requirement of the forest land as proposed by user agency in col. 2 of part I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
