


JOINT INSPECTION REPORT


The joint inspection of the site for the diversion of 1.62 hectare of forestland for the construction of Grahani Kasol (5.00 MW) Small Hydro Electric Power Project was carried out in the presence of staff of Forest Department and Revenue Department on 18th November, 2016.


The User Agency has proposed three different alignments. In 1st alignment total 1.62 hectare of forestland is involved with least number of trees getting affected. In 2nd alignment and 3rd alignment are rejected due to thick forest and more over topography of the same is not suitable for the water conductor system, penstock and slopes are not stable for construction of project. Since 1st alignment is geological more stable, involves minimum forest land and least number of trees, the same has been finalized and the 2nd alignment and 3rd alignment has been rejected by the joint inspection committee.

There is no scope of avoidance of forestland. However all efforts have been made to minimize the use of forestland. The diversion of 1.62 hectare of forestland is bare minimum and cannot be escaped.


