Respected Sir,

This is in reference to your letter no 2107; dated: 23.10.2024 in respect of forest diversion application of Magadh Railway Siding (121.29 Ha). The application for Magadh Railway Siding is under advance stage and double degraded forest land for subject proposal is already identified, details of which was also submitted with the proposal.

In compliance to the Van Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan Rules, 2023 regarding CA Land, CCL has undertaken numerous efforts to obtain Non-Forest Land for CA purpose for obtaining Stage II/Stage I Clearances for different projects (Mining as well as Railway Siding Projects).

Requests have been made to State Revenue authorities time and again for providing suitable non-forest as CA, required for forest land diversion. The revenue authorities have been persuaded at different levels to provide the non-forest land suitable for CA purpose. Correspondences made on this issue with State Authorities are enclosed as **Annexure I**. However, we are yet to firm up Non-Forest land Area that can be considered for CA purpose. In the meantime, MoEF & CC has issued amendment in Rule 13 of FC Rules, 2023 whereby it has indicated that double degraded forest land can be considered for CA purpose in exceptional circumstances.

Further it is to be submitted that the subject proposal for diversion of forest land is meant to construct environmental compliment evacuation infrastructure i.e. Railway Siding with a rapid loading system.

This plan is the part of ambitious **First Mile Connectivity (FMC)** policy of the **Ministry of Coal**, which is regularly monitored by the PMO office also to develop environmentally friendly practices. The construction of Railway Siding with silo has a projected capital investment of Rs. 402.10 Crore for the environment-compliant activity.

Magadh OCP which is a pioneer project of Central Coalfields Limited (CCL), is presently operating at the project capacity of 20MT per annum. **Coal India Board** has already approved the capacity expansion of Magadh OCP to the tune of 51MY per annum to meet the

increasing demand of coal in the Nation. However, capacity cannot be expanded without the construction of modern evacuation systems like Railway Siding, CHP, and Rapid Loading Systems.

Also, it is pertinent to mention that Similar type of request for use of degraded forest land double in area as CA land has already considered in subsidiaries of CIL (Kulda OCP, MCL), case study enclosed as **Annexure II**.


In view of the above subject proposal is of utmost importance for production capacity expansion of Magadh OCP which will be in turn helpful towards the energy security of the nation.

Dear Sir,

With respect to forest proposals mentioned under reference, Amrapali OCP has been granted stage-I on 21-12-2023 for diversion of 431.59 Ha land, and Amrapali railway siding has been granted stage-I on 17-01-2024 for diversion of 120.61 Ha land, with the following conditions related to CA:

a) Amrapali OCP (431.59 Ha)

"The compensatory afforestation over suitable non-forest land, equal in extent to the forest land being diverted i.e. 431.59 ha, shall be raised by the State Forest Department at the cost of the user agency...." (Annexure-I)

b) Amrapali Railway Siding (120.61 Ha)

"In accordance to Rule 13 and Rule 14 of Van (Sanrakshan & Samvardhan) Rules 2023, user agency shall provide land which is neither notified as forest under relevant forest laws nor managed as forest by State Forest Department for raising compensatory afforestation". (Annexure-II)

As such, a total of 431.59 Ha non-forest land for Amrapali OCP and 120.61 Ha non-forest land is required for the compensatory afforestation purpose.

Your good office is kindly requested to provide 552.2 Ha Government non-forest land for the CA purpose.

It may kindly be appreciated that Amrapali is the highest producing mine of CCL. The proposed coal evacuation system comprising of railway siding and CHP-Silo system (i.e. first mile connectivity to the rail evacuation point) are to come up in above parcels of forest land. Further, execution of railways siding and CHP-Silo are linked to the Environmental Clearance (EC) condition of the mine (Annexure-III, Page 2). Early


accordance of Stage-II of above two proposals will facilitate execution of coal evacuation system for the mine within the stipulated timeline of January 2025 to comply with EC condition.



Dear Sir,

This is to humbly intimate regarding Forest Clearances (FC) guidelines issued in Dec '23 by MoEF&CC New Delhi that, henceforth, only Non- forest land - equal in extent to the forest land for which clearance is sought - is to be identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation (CA). For this, the identified Non-Forest land is to be mutated in favour of State Forest Deptt. so that the cost of raising Afforestation thereon could be realized by State Forest Deptt. In the recent past, following two projects of CCL have been accorded Stage - I FC wherein the conditions regarding non - forest land for CA purpose have been clearly spelt out:

a) Amrapali OCP (431.59 Ha)

"The compensatory afforestation over suitable non-forest land, equal in extent to the forest land being diverted i.e. 431.59 ha, shall be raised by the State Forest Department at the cost of the user agency...."
(Annexure-I)

b) Amrapali Railway Siding (120.61 Ha)

"In accordance to Rule 13 and Rule 14 of Van (Sanrakshan & Samvardhan) Rules 2023, user agency shall provide land which is neither notified as forest under relevant forest laws nor managed as forest by State Forest Department for raising compensatory afforestation". (Annexure-II)

Thus, a total of 431.59 Ha non-forest land for Amrapali OCP and 120.61 Ha non-forest land is required for the compensatory afforestation purpose.

Vide letter mentioned under reference (Annexure-III), we have requested your good office to provide 552.2 Ha Government non-forest land for the CA purpose.



This is to humbly intimate that as per Forest Clearances (FC) guidelines issued in Dec '23 by MoEF&CC New Delhi, henceforth, only Non- forest land - equal in extent to the forest land for which clearance is sought - is to be identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation (CA). As per the new guideline, the Non-forest land identified (equal in extent to the Forest land diversion proposal) for the purpose of CA is to be mutated in favour of State Forest Deptt. The State Forest Deptt. will then realize the cost of raising Afforestation thereon. In the recent past, following two projects of CCL have been accorded Stage - I FC namely Amrapali OC (431.59 Ha) and Amrapali railway Siding (120.61 Ha) wherein the conditions regarding non - forest land for CA purpose have been clearly spelt out. Copy of FCs enclosed for kind reference.

Apart from the aforementioned Projects, placed below is the list of FC proposals which are likely to be impacted by the enactment of the condition of Equivalent Non-forest land for CA purpose.



Dear Sir,

It is to humbly mention that Forest Clearance (FC) guidelines issued by MoEF&CC, GOI in Dec'23 mandates providing non-forest land – equal in extent to the forest land for which clearance is sought for raising Compensatory Afforestation (CA). As per the above rules the identified non-forest land is to be handed over to State Forest deptt. In the recent past four projects of CCL have been accorded Stage I FC wherein conditions regarding non-forest land for CA purpose have been clearly spelt out:

a) Amrapali OCP (431.59 Ha)

"The compensatory afforestation over suitable non-forest land, equal in extent to the forest land being diverted i.e. 431.59 ha, shall be raised by the State Forest Department at the cost of the user agency...." (Enclosed as Annexure-I)

b) Amrapali Railway Siding (120.61 Ha)

"In accordance to Rule 13 and Rule 14 of Van (Sanrakshan & Samvardhan) Rules 2023, user agency shall provide land which is neither notified as forest under relevant forest laws nor managed as forest by State Forest Department for raising compensatory afforestation". (Enclosed as Annexure-II)

c) Magadh East OCP (192.36 Ha)

"The user agency shall provide suitable non-forest land equivalent to the forest land proposed to be diverted for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation. The same land shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest department and notified as protected forest under the provisions of Indian forest Act 1927 or the state specific laws; (Enclosed as Annexure-III)

d) Chandragupt OCP (699.38 Ha)

"The user agency shall provide suitable non-forest land equivalent to the forest land proposed to be diverted for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation. The same land shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest department and notified as protected forest under the provisions of Indian forest Act 1927 or the state specific laws; (Enclosed as Annexure-IV)

Thus, a total of 1443.94 Ha Non-Forest land is required for the Compensatory Afforestation (CA) purpose in respect of the above FC proposals. Vide letters mentioned under reference (Annexure V) requests have been made earlier to provide Government non-forest land for the CA purpose.


It is to further mention that additional Govt non-forest land to the tune of 5000 Ha will be needed by CCL for its upcoming/future projects where approximately 5000 Ha forest land is required to be diverted.

Early identification of Govt Non-Forest land will be of immense help in processing the aforementioned FC proposals for obtaining Stage II Forest Clearance. This will help CCL to achieve the ambitious target of 135 Million Tonne of Coal production with a required growth of 57% from the current level to fulfill the rising coal demand of our country.

**Subject: Request to arrange for providing Govt. land identified by CCL
for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation (CA) land.**

Dear Sir,

As you may kindly be aware that during Global Climate Change Conference (COP-21) at Paris, Govt. of India had pledged to create an additional carbon sink of 2.5 to 3 billion tonnes of CO₂ equivalent through additional tree cover by 2030. Further, Govt. Of India through its National Forest Policy envisages attaining 33 % forest cover in years to come. Accordingly, to fulfill the above goals through augmentation of green cover, MoEFCC, Govt. of India has recently amended the FC Act and Rules and as per Van (Sanrakshan Evar Samvardhan) Adhiniyam Rules, 2023, henceforth, only Non-forest land - equal to the forest land proposed for diversion - is to be identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation (CA). Non-forest land so identified is to be mutated in favour of State Forest Department, which subsequently will realize the cost of raising Afforestation thereon from user agency.

To meet the rising coal demand of country and the State, CCL has envisaged to produce 100 MT of coal in this fiscal and 135 MT in next year for which new/expansion coal projects have been planned for which CCL requires approx. 6300 Ha of Non-forest Govt. land for CA purpose to obtain FC under various proposals (copy of list of proposals enclosed). For this, CCL undertook an exercise for identification of GMK and GMA land in different districts of Jharkhand through website Jharbhoomi and Bhunaksha portal of GoJ.

Against the above identification, 550.18 acres (222.65 Ha) of Non-forest Govt. land has been identified in Garhwa district (copy enclosed), which requires further examination from the different land ledgers being maintained in the office of District and Circles so that encumbrance free land could be filtered out and can be used for CA purpose after paying requisite statutory compensation / fee payable to Govt of Jharkhand.

In light of above, you are requested to kindly direct the concerned CO and other officials for identification of required encumbrance free Non-forest Govt. land from the list of plots identified by CCL or other land suitable for CA purpose. The land so identified will be handed over to State forest department for raising CA, which will enhance the overall green cover of district resulting in improved environmental parameters in and around the area.

**Subject: Request to arrange for providing Govt. land identified by CCL
for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation (CA) land.**

Dear Sir,

As you may kindly be aware that during Global Climate Change Conference (COP-21) at Paris, Govt. of India had pledged to create an additional carbon sink of 2.5 to 3 billion tonnes of CO₂ equivalent through additional tree cover by 2030. Further, Govt. Of India through its National Forest Policy envisages attaining 33 % forest cover in years to come. Accordingly, to fulfill the above goals through augmentation of green cover, MoEFCC, Govt. of India has recently amended the FC Act and Rules and as per Van (Samrakshan Evarn Samvardhan) Adhiniyam Rules, 2023, henceforth, only Non-forest land - equal to the forest land proposed for diversion - is to be identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation (CA). Non-forest land so identified is to be mutated in favour of State Forest Department, which subsequently will realize the cost of raising Afforestation thereon from user agency.

To meet the rising coal demand of country and the State, CCL has envisaged to produce 100 MT of coal in this fiscal and 135 MT in next year for which new/expansion coal projects have been planned for which CCL requires approx. 6300 Ha of Non-forest Govt. land for CA purpose to obtain FC under various proposals (copy of list of proposals enclosed). For this, CCL undertook an exercise for identification of GMK and GMA land in different districts of Jharkhand through website Jharbhoomi and Bhunaksha portal of GoJ.

Against the above identification, 1287.07 acres (520.81 Ha) of Non-forest Govt. land has been identified in Giridih district (copy enclosed), which requires further examination from the different land ledgers being maintained in the office of District and Circles so that encumbrance free land could be filtered out and can be used for CA purpose after paying requisite statutory compensation / fee payable to Govt of Jharkhand.

In light of above, you are requested to kindly direct the concerned CO and other officials for identification of required encumbrance free Non-forest Govt. land from the list of plots identified by CCL or other land suitable for CA purpose. The land so identified will be handed over to State forest department for raising CA, which will enhance the overall green cover of district resulting in improved environmental parameters in and around the area.



Dear Sir,


As you may kindly be aware that during Global Climate Change Conference (COP-21) at Paris, Govt. of India had pledged to create an additional carbon sink of 2.5 to 3 billion tonnes of CO₂ equivalent through additional tree cover by 2030. Further, Govt. Of India through its National Forest Policy envisages attaining 33 % forest cover in years to come. Accordingly, to fulfill the above goals through augmentation of green cover, MoEFCC, Govt. of India has recently amended the FC Act and Rules and as per Van (Sanrakshan Evarn Samvardhan) Adhiniyam Rules, 2023, henceforth, only Non-forest land - equal to the forest land proposed for diversion - is to be identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation (CA). Non-forest land so identified is to be mutated in favour of State Forest Department, which subsequently will realize the cost of raising Afforestation thereon from user agency.

To meet the rising coal demand of country and the State, CCL has envisaged to produce 100 MT of coal in this fiscal and 135 MT in next year for which new/expansion coal projects have been planned for which CCL requires approx. 6300 Ha of Non-forest Govt. land for CA purpose to obtain FC under various proposals (copy of list of proposals enclosed). For this, CCL undertook an exercise for identification of GMK and GMA land in different districts of Jharkhand through website Jharbhoomi and Bhunaksha portal of GoJ.

Against the above identification, 2899.95 acres (1173.59 Ha) of Non-forest Govt. land has been identified in Saraikela-Kharsawa district (copy enclosed), which requires further examination from the different land ledgers being maintained in the office of District and Circles so that encumbrance free land could be filtered out and can be used for CA purpose after paying requisite statutory compensation / fee payable to Govt of Jharkhand.

In light of above, you are requested to kindly direct the concerned CO and other officials for identification of required encumbrance free Non-forest Govt. land from the list of plots identified by CCL or other land suitable for CA purpose. The land so identified will be handed over to State forest department for raising CA, which will enhance the overall green cover of district resulting in improved environmental parameters in and around the area.



This is to state that MoEF&CC, New Delhi, has issued Forest Clearance (FC) in Dec'2023 which mentions that equivalent non-forest land is to be identified to the extent of forest land for which clearance is required and be provided to State Forest Deptt. (not less than 10 Ha in a single chunk if the boundary of any identified plot doesn't share with forest land) Further, the State forest deptt. will also demand cost for raising Afforestation on such identified land.

With the introduction of this guideline, CCL is in need of about 600 Ha of non-forest land required for its different forest proposals (list enclosed) for clearance. The target of Coal production in the current FY is 100 MT and in the next FY to 135 MT. To achieve the same, timely forestry clearance is necessarily required of the acquired forest land. It has been found from the records that about 766 Ha of GM Khas land is available in your district.



ii. Compensatory afforestation, as per the provisions of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023, should be raised over non-forest/revenue forest land or the lands accredited under ACA can also be swapped in lieu of CA. The State Government may, therefore, inform the details of mined out and reclaimed non-forest lands available with M/S MCL and possibility of using them as CA.

2. First time compliance submitted by MCL to DFO Sundargarh dtd 26.07.2024

ii) *Compensatory afforestation, as per the provisions of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules 2023, should be raised over non-forest / revenue forest land or the lands accredited under ACA can also be swapped in lieu of CA. The state government may, therefore, inform the details of mined out and reclaimed non-forest lands available with M/S. MCL and possibility of using them as CA.*

In compliance to the above, this is to submit that the land for Compensatory Afforestation in the form of non forest land / revenue forest land is being searched for and will be submitted as soon as it is obtained. An undertaking to this effect is being submitted herewith.

3. Query raised by DFO Sundargarh on 20.09.2024

With reference to the letter cited above, the compliance report vide No.(i) to (viii) to the observation raised by MoEF letter No.8-7/2024-FC dated 11.06.2024, with an undertaking vide condition No.(ii) has been submitted to higher quarter. Subsequently, observation raised by Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Forest Diversion & Nodal Officer, FC-Act and the compliance report vide condition No. (ii) are incomplete due to non- providing the non-forest land/ Revenue non-forest or the lands accredited under ACA can also be swapped in lieu of Compensatory Afforestation vide Memo under reference, against the proposed diverted land for Kulta Expansion OCP of MCL.

In view of the above the higher quarters are pressing hard and conduct review meeting regularly in this matter.

Furthermore, it has come to our notice, that the information provided to the undersigned, regarding certain compliance matters were either incomplete or inaccurate vide condition No. (ii). This has resulted for non-submission of compliance report to proceed with the necessary action.

Therefore, you are asked to provide a written explanation of the above circumstances, to this Office at an early.

4. Compliance submitted by MCL on 12.10.2024

We acknowledge your suggestion for provisioning of Revenue non-forest land or lands accredited under the ACA in lieu of compensatory afforestation. However, in light of the new Gazette notifications issued by the Government of India on 20.09.2024 (Copy enclosed), which relaxes the requirements for Central Public Sector Undertakings regarding the use of Degraded Reserve Forest Land for Compensatory Afforestation, we request that the CA Scheme already approved by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (PCCF) Nodal may kindly be considered for this project. This CA Scheme has been vetted and recommended by the State Government of Odisha and subsequently submitted to MoEF&CC as well.

As per the dispensation provided in Forest (Conservation) Rules 2003, i.e. CA shall be raised and maintained at the cost of the user agency on degraded forest land twice in extent of the forest area diverted in the cases of projects implemented by the Central Government/PSUs, the CA land for Kulda Expansion OCP was identified and allotted in four patches of Degraded Reserve Forest Land at Gopalpur Range of Sundargarh Forest Division.

5. Query raised by DFO Sundargarh on 14.10.2024

With reference to the letter cited above, the observation raised vide condition No.(ii) by Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Forest Diversion & Nodal Officer, FC-Act, as per new notification by MoEF & CC, Government of India, the degraded forest land already identified for compensatory Afforestation purpose for the year, 2022 and which will be sent to Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Forest Diversion & Nodal Officer, FC-Act, O/o the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & HoFF(O) vide Memo under reference, against the proposed diverted land for Kulda Expansion OCP of MCL.

Now, it was required to check, if there is any encroachment or plantation of proposed CA land, in the mean time, in the identified Compensatory Afforestation area in Padripani RF, Sidarmunda RF, Panikholia RF & Punjipahad RF.

Therefore, you are requested to contact with the Range Officer, Gopalpur to conduct field verification of the above CA area and report compliance.

6. Field verification by Range Officer, Gopalpur Range, Orissa dtd 15.10.2024

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, I am submitting here with the field verification report of CA-Land area in Pandripani RF-64.10Ha, Sidarmunda RF-53.56Ha, Panikholia RF-56.39Ha & Punjipahad RF-131.54Ha which were identified for Compensatory Afforestation of Kulda Expansion OCP of MCL for diversion of 134.69 Ha in presence of User-Agency Staff on dated-15.10.2024. At the time of verification in field at Pandripani RF CA-Land over 64.10Ha some area i.e. 7.8 ha found encroached and 0.29Ha encroached area in Panikholia RF CA-Land over 56.39Ha which is excluded from the allocated CA-Land area. In Punjipahad RF CA-Land over 131.54Ha there was found a MGNREGA ANR Plantation 50Ha raised during 2021-22 but 10.54Ha planting patches were excluded from the CA-Land area & In Sidarmunda RF CA-Land over 53.56 Ha there was not found any encroachment area. There was not found new encroachment activity and new plantation site has been taken up inside the above identified CA-Land area.

This is for favour of your kind information and necessary action.

7. DFO Sundargarh to RCCF, Rourkela dtd 18.10.2024

In inviting a reference to the Memo cited above, the EDS reply submitted by the User Agency i.e Project Officer, Kulda OCP of MCL, as per Gazette notifications issued by MoEF & CC, Government of India on dated 20.09.2024 (**Copy enclosed**), relating to use of Degraded Reserve Forest land by the Central PSC for Compensatory Afforestation over **286.96Ha** for Kulda Expansion OCP of MCL.

Based on the report of Range Officer, Gopalpur, over an area of **Pandripani RF-56.3Ha**, **Sidarmunda-53.56Ha**, **Panikholia RF-56.1Ha** & **Punjipahad RF-121Ha (Total-286.96Ha)** in the identified proposed Compensatory Afforestation and there was not found any encroachment activity or new plantation site has been taken up in the proposed area. Further, over an area of **286.96Ha** for CA Plantation has been technically approved by the Principal Chief Conservator Forests, Forest Diversion & Nodal Officer, FC-Act with a financial outlay of **Rs.9,54,46,100/-** (**Copy enclosed**).

Therefore, the EDS reply along with copy of new Gazette notifications, report of Range Officer, Gopalpur & financial outlay of Compensatory Afforestation over **286.96Ha** are enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and onward transmission to higher quarters.

8. RCCF Rourkela to Nodal Officer, Orissa dtd 23.10.2024

In compliance with the observations communicated vide your memo No.18383 Dtd.10.09.2024, the User Agency has submitted their reply as per the Gazette Notifications Dtd.20.09.2024 of the MoEF & CC, GoI as regarding the use of degraded forest land by the Central PSUs for Compensatory Afforestation purpose and thereby they have requested to consider their proposal for Compensatory Afforestation over **305.59 ha** (Effective area 289.96 ha) of degraded forest land for Kulda Expansion OCP of MCL.

Further, as stated by the DFO, Sundargarh Division, the aforesaid extent of degraded RF land over 286.96 ha comprising of **56.30 ha in Pandripani RF**, **53.56 Ha in Sidarmunda**, **56.10 ha in Panikholia RF** & **121 ha in Punjipahad RF** proposed Compensatory Afforestation is neither found to have been encroached nor any new plantation has been taken up there as per the report of the Range Officer, Gopalpur. Further, the CA Scheme over the said extent of **286.96 Ha** of degraded forest land has already been approved by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests(FD & NO, FC Act), with a financial outlay of **Rs.9,54,46,100/-** (**Copy enclosed**).
