


The compliance report to the EDs raised by Regional Officer, Integrated Regional Office, Jammu vide his letter under reference is submitted as under;

#	EDs raised	Compliance report
1	DGPS map needs to be revised because as per DSS Analysis report, latitude/longitude reading for dumping site, as well as from one side of forest diversion land starting/ending latitude/longitude is missing.	The desired correction stated done by user agency.
2	This proposal involves felling of 422 number of trees, hence the CA area shall be $422 \times 10 = 4220$ no of saplings i.e.,; at least 4.22 ha of CA land has to be proposed. Accordingly, the DGPS map, SOI toposheet and Site Suitability certificate shall be modified.	The total area for Compensatory Afforestation has been taken 4.64 ha ($4.22 + 10\%$), revised DGPS map, SOI Toposheet, CA scheme and site suitability certificate stands uploaded in the proposed at appropriate places.
3	Comments and recommendations from CWLW in view of presence of wildlife in the proposed area shall be submitted,	The comments and recommendation of Chief Wildlife Warden, J&K are attached with proposal.




Subject: Diversion of 0.99 Ha of forest land for construction of road from Peerah (NHAI) to Kameti, District Ramban, UT of Jammu & Kashmir- reg (Proposal No. FP/JK/Road/151949/2022).

The animal passage plan for Wildlife proposed with respect to road project mentioned in the subject, as prepared by the User Agency in consultation with Divisional Forest Officer, Batote Forest Division and Wildlife Warden, Chenab Division, Kishtwar has been examined and found to have the necessary components i.e under passes, speed breakers and provision for sign boards/ cautionary warning signs. The said animal passage plan for Wildlife is as such approved subject to following conditions:-

01. Divisional Forest Officer, Batote Forest Division, shall ensure that under passes as specified in the animal passage plan are constructed by the user Agency.
02. No harm to any Wildlife species shall be done, if found accidentally in the project area.
03. The User Agency shall construct speed breakers at critical Wildlife passage areas to be specified by the concerned Wildlife Warden.
04. Divisional Forest Officer, Batote Forest Division shall ensure that adequate number of sign boards and cautionary warning signs are installed by the User Agency along the road stretch.
05. Divisional Forest Officer, Batote Forest Division, shall ensure that all the provisions made in the animal passage plan are strictly executed by the User Agency.
06. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue.



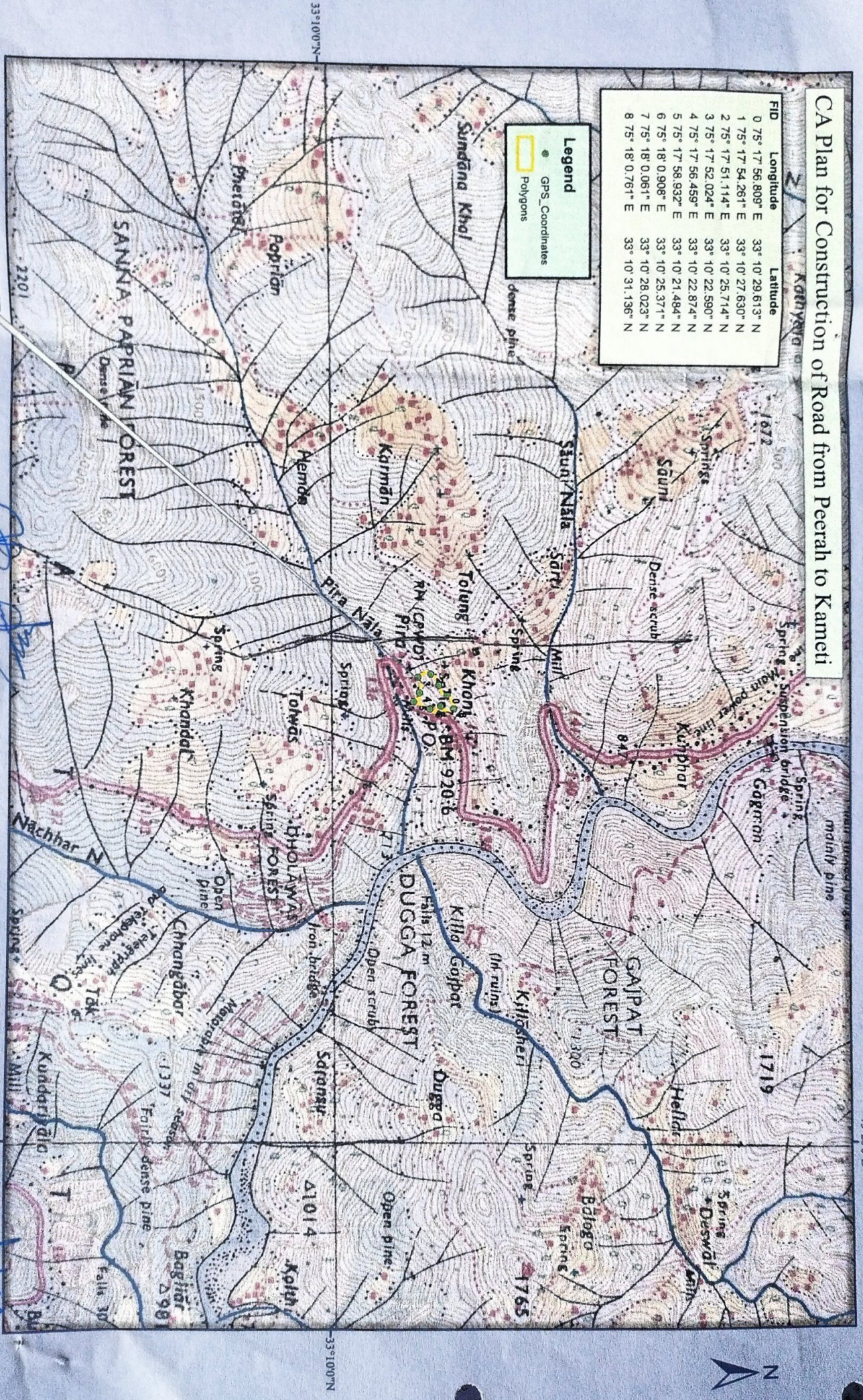
