

**CERTIFICATE TO BE FURNISHED BY THE COLLECTOR OF THE
CONCERNED DISTRICT**

1. It is certified that the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been carried out for the entire forest area of 73.697 hectares of Kalarangi village proposed for diversion for Sukinda Chromite Mines Project of TATA Steel Ltd. The concerned record of all consultations and Meetings held are annexed.
2. It is certified that the proposals for such diversion have been placed before each of the Gram Sabhas of forest dwellers who are eligible under the Forest Rights Act. Details of the projects and its implications have been explained to them in vernacular/local language.
3. It is certified that discussions and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of members of the Gram Sabha present.
4. It is certified that the rights of primitive tribal groups and pre-agricultural communities have been specifically safeguarded as per Section 3(1) (e) of the Forest Rights Act.
5. It is certified that the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by Government as required under Section 3 (2) of the Forest Rights Act (if any) have been completed and that the Gram Sabha have consented to it.

PROCEEDING OF GRAM SABHA MEETING ON FOREST RIGHTS ACT, 2006

The Gram Sabha of village- Kalarangi under Forest Rights Act, 2006 (under sub-section-1 of section 2 of Forest Rights Act. 2006) was held on 13.12.2011 at 2.00 PM in Kalarangi Dehurisahi under the Chairmanshaip of Sarpanch, Ransol G.P. in obedience to District Office Letter No. 1530 Dt. 01.08.11, Letter No. 2075 Dt. 06.09.2011 of Tahasildar, Sukinda & Letter No. 3000 Dt. 07.12.11 of Block Development Officer, Sukinda.

The following members were present in the Gram Sabha.

Detail discussion was made on diversion proposal of Sukinda Chromite Mines of TATA Steel Ltd. and its functioning by the user agency. Besides the facilities available in the Rules & Regulations of Scheduled Tribes and Other Forest Dwellers Act, 2006 was narrated in the Gram Sabha. The proposal for diversion of 73.697 Hec. or A182.110 dec. submitted by Sukinda Chromite Mines, TATA Steel Ltd. is placed before the Gram Sabha with the map of diversion area.

The field enquiry report conducted by R.I., Kankadopal as per Forest Rights Act, 2006 was placed before the Gram Sabha. Sukinda Chromite Mines, TATA Steel Ltd. applied for diversion proposal on Ac. 247.11 of Mouza- Kalarangi is under forest land. On enquiry it reveals that neither any individuals nor any Scheduled Tribes are in possession on the said land nor any Scheduled Tribes and

1. In view of traditional F.C.R., Dwellers applied their claim for availing Title to the Gram Sabha under Forest Rights Act, 2006.

2. In view of the fact that there is no objection will be raised by any villagers, if 73.527 Hectare of 100 dec. of Forest Land will be diverted to Sukinda Chromite Mines, TATA Steel Ltd. Villagers present in the meeting unanimously accepted the diversion of 100 dec. of Mouza- Kalarangi for rising of Mines.
