3. Banks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use is to be obtained from the irrigation authorities.

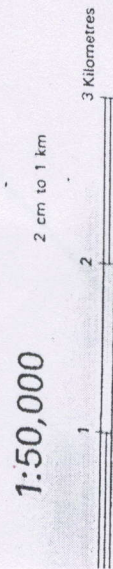
4. 100 metres apart and every fifth stone is shown.
