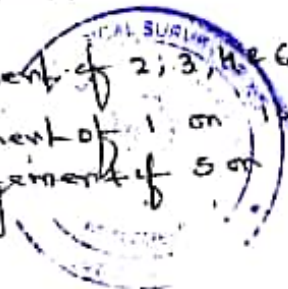

Sir,

The undersigned visited the Sandur (North) ie Ramendunga north & south block on 14th & 15th Novem 2017 which were given by DGM, Karnataka forest dept. The details of the bore hole for the block wise is given below.

① Form - C Proposal no (GA/CI 16 MMM 2003) FP/KA/MRL/2/2017

- No drilling - No tree felling

② FORM - C Proposal no (13/1 South) FP/KA/MRL/3/2017

16 bore holes to be drilled - All road existing without any tree felling

③ FORM - C Proposal No (13/1 North) FP/KA/MRL/4/2017

There are 8 nos of Bore holes. The details of which are as follows

1. KBRN 01 - No road making and no tree cutting and hence using the existing road
2. KBRN 03 - 10 mts road making from existing road. No tree felling. Only bushes.
3. KBRN - 04 - No tree felling. No road making and hence using existing road
4. KBRN - 05 - 165 mts road existing with bushes mainly grass from main road. No tree felling & cutting
5. KBRN - 06 - 115 mts - making of road from main road only bushes no tree cutting
6. KBRN - 08 - 10 mts road making with out bush and no tree cutting

7. KBRN - 09 - 60 mts new road making from existing Road with bushes. No tree felling.
8. KBRN - 13 - 104 mts existing Road. No bush and no tree cutting.

④ Form - C Proposal no (GBCI 16 MMM 2003) FP/KA/MRL/5/2017

There are one two bores to be drilled. The details are as follows

1. KBRN/11 - Adjacent to existing Road. Hence no tree cutting and no tree felling
2. KBRN/12 - Adjacent to existing Road. Hence no tree cutting and no tree felling

You are requested to make manager report and submit to the Dy CF, Bellary to make point no.5 complaint with the letter issued by Dy CF Bellary on 7.11.17.
