COST BENEFIT ANALYSIS

The villages of the nearby proposed area of Sand, Gravel and Boulder collection namely Ghagar Sand, Gravel and Boulder mahal are mostly poor and as there is insufficient land for cultivation, they are mostly dependent on various minor minerals mahals, stone crusher units, brick industries, fuel wood collection etc. and also migrate to other parts of the State/Country seeking works for their livelihood, if this project is allowed it will generate rural employment opportunities, thereby raising their socio-economic condition in addition to huge revenue to the State exchequer.
