The Forest Settlement Officer has passed orders under Section 11 of the Forest Act in F.S. O. No. 182/67 dt. 28-8-75 rejecting the claim on the ground that already 160 acres was ordered to be eliminated from the proposed Reserve Forest and that would be sufficient for communal purpose and that free grazing is allowed even in Reserve Forests No appeals have been preferred and the Divisional Forest Officer, Nellore has implemented the Forest Settlement Officer's Award passed in F. S. O. No. C. 182/81 dt 28-7-1972 and he has sent a revised sketch eliminating an extent of 160 Ac. from the proposed Reserved Forest.

The patta land, belongs to Smt M. Venkata-subbamma over an extent of Ac. 20.75 in S. No. 41 of Vempallithoka village was included in Seetharampuram Forest Block. As per the directions of High Court, A. P. Hyderabad the Government in G. O. Rt. No. 170 E.F.E.S. and T. (For VI-2) Dep. rtment dt. 18-3-92, had accorded sanction of Rs. 1,93,182/towards the payment of cash compensation payable to Smt. D. V. Lakshamma D/o. Venkatasubbamma for the acquired land in S. No. 41 of Vempallithoka over 20.75 Acs. Accordingly that the said amount was paid to the claimant through a crossed cheque bearing No. 3073/307227 dated 26-3-92.
