## Queries raised

## L. Details of land identified for Compensatory Afforestation

- Two blocks the first one mentioning an extent of 9.69 hectare in Halbhavi Village Sy No. 39, Raichur District and another with an extent of 0.298 hectare in Kuruvalli Village, Ballari District are proposed for CA as against actual requirement of 8.47 hectare (or ~8.5 hectare).
- RTC uploaded for Halbhavi Village Sy No. 39 shows the land to be in the name of one Durgamma w/o Basanagouda, whereas the Deed of Conveyance dated 25-10-2018 shows the land (20 acre 20 Gunta or 8.296 hectare excluding the balance Pot kharab land out of total 23 acre 38 Gunta) to have been sold by Durgamma w/o Basanagouda as 'Seller' to Forest Department as 'Buyer' on behalf of M/s JSW.
- CA land is proposed in two widely separated blocks (one being just 0.298 hectare) which is connected to another 0.55 hectare land parcel (mentioned as earmarked as CA land in Proposal No. FP/KA/TRANS/21139/2008) only through a common corner point. Further, the Stage-I approval in the said proposal has already been revoked by GOJ on 19-12-2014 and thus there is no such proposal or proposed CA land parcel as of now and thus cannot be taken as a CA land. Such a small land parcel not adjoining to any accepted CA land parcel is not manageable and thus not suitable for CA purpose.
  - 1. Please propose the CA land parcel in a single block only, as these lands are to be monitored in future against particular proposals. If it is at all inevitable, each of the two proposed CA land parcels should be adjoining to either an existing (notified) forest land or to a CA land parcel already accepted in a Stage-I/II approved Proposal.
  - 2. Please mention the figure 8.296 hectare (and not 9.69 hectare) in Item L(iv)(b) for Halbhavi land parcel.
  - 3. Please upload a Tabular Statement showing the
