With reference to the above subject, in the reference no.3, the District Forest Officer  
informed through letter for this proposal as follows:

“ The above proposal was examined with ref to the existing procedures laid down under  
Forest Conservation ACT-1980 Rules framed. You have requested for laying of OFC along the  
Road side in Egumadurai RF and Kondamanallur RF in Gummudipoondi Range. The proposal  
requested for laying of OFC along the Road in Egumadurai RF and Kondamanallur RF are not  
admitted right of way. It is also to point that there are feasibilities for laying the OFC outside the  
RF limits. For the reasons stated above the request of the user Agency is not considered”.

1. In this connection, we wish to submit that we had attached a certificate from the District  
Collector, mentioning ‘no alternate lands other than forest lands that are available’; This may  
be considered.
2. Moreover it is submitted that, this proposal is not ‘within the right way’ but ‘along the right of  
way’;
3. Further we wish to add that this proposal is for a ‘diversion proposal’; it's not under the re-  
diversion proposal.
