

JOINT INSPECTION REPORT

Joint Inspection of forest land proposed for diversion for construction of Helipad at Key. The forest land involved is in Key Kothi Tatpa.

Whereas joint inspection of land measuring 0.92 Hac. of forest land in muhal Key Kothi Tatpa in Tehsil Kaza is conducted as per the direction of Additional Deputy Commissioner Kaza in the presence of DFO Wild Life Division Kaza, SDM Kaza, Executive Engineer HPPWD Division Kaza, Executive Engineer I & PH Division Kaza and Executive Engineer Electricity Division Kaza on dated 18.09.2018.

The proposed forest land applied for construction of Helipad at Key Kothi Tatpa is recommended as the same is minimum and unavoidable. There is no other alternative land available for the same purpose as per the revenue records. The status of land applied from the forest area is Charand. The diversion of the above forest land will not interface with the existing road and drinking/ irrigation water supply scheme. There is no any natural source for drinking water on the proposed forest land. There is only one transmission line passing through the proposed site. It is decided during the inspection by the Joint Inspection Committee the transmission line will be shifted to another suitable place and the all expenses occurred by the user agency.

Hence, land required as per detail cited above for the construction of Helipad at Key Kothi Tatpa, by HPPWD Division Kaza is barest minimum and justified for the construction. It is decided to recommend the case to the Govt. for approval.
