It is further certified that:-

- a) An area of 0.7511 Hectare of protected forest land is proposed to be diverted for non-forestry purpose favor of Vindhya Telelinks Ltd., for laying of OFC along with below roads ROW in Social Forestry Division of Fatehpur District.
