

2.	Please upload the report of the Joint Verification of the proposed land to be diverted countersigned by the concerned authorities involved in the JV process	It has been uploaded.
3.	Please upload the muck disposal plan with regards to the proposed forest land to be diverted	For the proposed road project total earthwork cut volume is 353834cum and fill volume is =370349cum. Earth available from cutting is proposed to be utilised in embankment filling. As fill volume of earth is more than the cut volumeno muck (excess earth) will be generated and hence muck disposal plan is not required.
4.	Please upload the cross-sectional diagram of the proposed road project road	It has been uploaded
