Sir,

With reference to the above cited letter and as per the field report received from the Range officer, Harmutty Range, I am furnishing herewith the following information as asked by you,

1. The Aerial distance of the proposed transmission line is 55 Km from the nearest protected area i.e. 6<sup>th</sup> addition of Kaziranga Tiger Reserve cum National Park.
2. The distance from the point bearing GPS Co-ordinates N 27° 13'52.09" E 93°55'35.3" to the point bearing GPS Co-ordinates N= 27° 13'33.25" E= 93°53'18.53" along the proposed transmission line, lies inside the Ranga Reserve Forest. The rest of the area along the transmission line is non-forest land.
