

Avenue Plantation in respect of diversion of 0.26ha of Forest land for construction of Sanskrit Pathsala & Panchanageshwar Shiva Mandir at Chandmari in East District of Sikkim by Panchanageshwar Shiva Mandir Committee, Chandmari, East Sikkim.

1. INTRODUCTION:-

General Secretary, Sanskrit Pathsala & Panchanageshwar Shiva Mandir has proposed for diversion of 0.26 ha of Forest land for construction of Sanskrit Pathsala & Panchanageswar Shiva Mandir at Chandmari in East District of Sikkim. The forest land involved is **0.26 ha falls under Sarkar land within plot no.38 (P)** and the stipulation would be double the area proposed for diversion i.e. 0.52ha.

The Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India has prescribed the following guidelines for diversion:-

- i. In all cases the legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii. User agency would have to pay the cost of compensatory afforestation to the State Forest Department.
- iii. The compensatory afforestation for avenue plantation shall be raised over an area of 1km of forest land to make good any loss of forest and also to maintain the ecological balance in the locality.

3. INTEGRATED PROGRAMME / METHODOLOGY OF WORKS FOR EXECUTION.

- i. **Seedling Requirement:** The requirement of seedlings may be met from the existing Nurseries of the Department on payment basis as per the approved rates. The existing nurseries will have to be provided with the seeds of mixed species including the cost of nursery implements used.
- ii. **Choice of species:** Mixed plantation of site specific species shall be done.
- iii. **Executing Agency:** The works under the Scheme shall be executed by the of Forest, Environment & Wildlife Management Department, Government of Sikkim through East Territorial Division and Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 Cell as per the approval of the Government.
- iv. **Monitoring & Evaluation:** All the activities under the Scheme may be monitored by a committee constituted for the purpose, Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the representative from Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India concurrently and regularly.
