

	Available in the vicinity and the proposed forest diversion area and details about how so far they reached their patta lands	road is the forest road (located in the Survey number 632 of Ooty rural village Dodabetta Panchayath) is used by the user agency to reach their patta lands
6	As per the Forest conservation Act 1980 guidelines- loss of forest area should be compensated with area and loss of trees should be compensated with trees only. The user agency should demarcate their patta land double the extent of forest land proposed for diversion in the area adjoining to forest land as a compensatory afforestation land and furnish the details for consideration of forest clearance proposal under FC act 1980	The profile of the proposed diversion of the forest land is road-The user agency is going to use the road as approach to their patta lands. Hence there wont be any chopping of trees in the proposed forest road. As we have planted close to 2000 shola tress in our patta land which is abutting the forest road and the same is going to be handed over as OSR (Open Space Reservation) to the local body, we will not have any patta lands left to allot for the afforestation land for the forest department.The user agency is scouting for land for afforestation, we will upload the details and the Sale agreement once we decide on the land.
7	The User Agency is informed to obtain District Collector's certificate of process for Settlement of Rights Act 2006 on the Forest area proposed for diversion and upload the same in Section K	Collector certificate will be obtained and the same is uploaded in Section K
