Subject : Regarding Aerial distance of the proposed area from the nearest Tiger Reserved / National Park / Wildlife Sanctuary / Biosphere Reserve.

With reference to the subject cited above, I would like to inform you that as per Geo Coordinate & field survey, it is seen that the proposed natural gas pipe line passes through Eco-Sensitive Zone of Borail Wildlife Sanctuary from the GPS Co-ordinates N25 02 08.45 E92 24 58.30 to N24 59 54.79 E92 26 18.53.

The Aerial distance between proposed pipeline and the boundary of Borail Wildlife Sanctuary (West Block) varies between 3.20 Km to 4.33 Km.

A Geo Map illustrating aerial distance and Eco-Sensitive Zone pertaining to Borail Wildlife Sanctuary and proposed pipe line is enclosed herewith for your kind perusal.
