

**DETAIL PROJECT REPORT: CONSTRUCTION OF NEW LINK ROAD
FROM LAMPOKHARI TO BOGBOGEY TURNING, ARITAR
IN EAST SIKKIM.**

1. PURPOSE: Construction of new link road from Lampokhari to Bogbogeey Turning, Aritar, East Sikkim.
2. AREA OF LAND ACQUISITION: New link road from Lampokhari to Bogbogeey Turning, Aritar, East Sikkim.
 - (a) Total length of the road: 490 meters.
 - (b) Length of the road under Khasmal Forest: 390 meters.
 - (c) Total area of Forest land required: 0.1950 hec.

3. GENERAL:

- (a) Short narrative of the proposal and project/ scheme for which the forest land is required.

The name of the project is "Construction of new link road from Lampokhari to Bogbogeey Turning" falling under Roads & Bridges Department, Government of Sikkim. The length of the road is 490 meters. The work mentioned above was sanctioned by the government during the "**Jan Sampark Abhiyan**" of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of the state at various constituencies during the year 2018. The link road proposed connects the existing SH-Rongli- Dalapchand- Aritar and PMGSY road heading towards Pradhan Gaon.

(e) Cost benefit analysis: The benefits of this project are as follows:

1. This road is a vital link road connecting the rural areas of Lampokhari (festival ground), Bhotey Gaon and Pradhan Gaon etc. for socio- economic up-liftman of the rural masses.
2. It link road will connect the major road to Aritar Lake i.e. recreational place. Commuting for the locals as well as tourist from neighboring states visiting Aritar Lakes will become much more easier.
3. The link road will also benefit the students of Pradhan Gaon, Bhotey Gaon studying at Aritar Senior Secondary School as this route provides a shorter and a less time travel option.
4. It will provide access to social, health and education services and also boost tourism opportunity to local people.

4. **Justification** for locating the project in forest area.

Proposed area for connecting the existing SH-Rongli-Dalapchand-Aritar and PMGSY road heading towards Pradhan Gaon, Maney Dara is the only alternative route inconsideration with minimum damage done to forest cover and environment.

Employment likely to be generated:

During the initial work, temporary employment will be generated for skilled and un-skilled man power of the adjoin locality. The local can benefit by way of petty contract and construction of protective works. After completion of the road network opportunities of employment for locals in transport sector and tourism sector will improve as the area offers various recreational and is a potential tourist hub.
