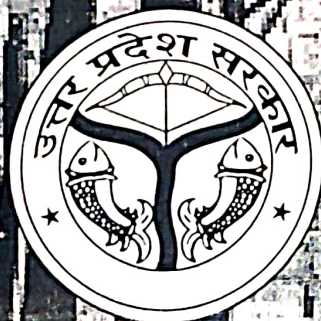

Sir, &

Please refer to your above-mentioned letter vide which Working Plan of Social Forestry Division Bijnaur, Uttar Pradesh for the period 2019-20 to 2028-29, was submitted to this office for approval.

The working plan of Social Forestry Division, Bijnaur, for the period 2005-06 to 2014-15, was approved vide this office letter No. ROC/WP/59/97/554 dated 05-01-2007. Thereafter, an extension proposal for the period 2015-16 to 2016-17 was submitted by the UP-Forest Department and approval was accorded by this office vide letter No. ROC/WP/69/97/EC/64 dated 06-10-2016. Further, another proposal for approval of extension of the working plan for the period from 01-10-2017 to 30-09-2019 was received in this office after the recommendation of the State Level Standing Technical Committee in its meeting held on 10-05-2013. The extension for Working Plan of Social Forestry Division, Bijnaur for the period from 01-04-2017 to 30-09-2019 was accorded vide this office letter No. ROC/WP/16/97/319 dated 04-07-2019. The proposal for approval of Working Plan of Social Forestry Division, Bijnaur for the period 2019-20 to 2028-29 for 10 years has been submitted vide the above cited letter, after the recommendation of State Level Standing Consultative Committee in its meeting held on 16-09-2019.

The draft Working Plan under consideration, has been examined with the provisions of the Forests (Conservation) Act, 1980, the guidelines of the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, Delhi from time to time; National Forest Policy, 1988; the order of Hon'ble court in PIL WP (C) No. 202/95 dated 12.12.96 read with WP (C) No. 202/95 and subsequent orders passed in the different IAs by the Hon'ble Supreme Court; National Working Plan Code, 2014.

After careful consideration of the proposal and observations submitted, the undersigned is hereby conveying the approval of Working Plan of S. Division, Bijnaur, Uttar Pradesh, for the period 1st October 2019 to 30 September 2023 on following terms and conditions:

1. All information provided subsequent to submission of working plan shall be treated as part of Working Plan and would be incorporated in the approved proposal.
2. The Divisional area statement submitted by PCCF, Moradabad, dated 21-11-2018, vide letter No. 366/12-5-1-II (Moradabad), dated 21-11-2018, shall be treated as final for the area of this Working Plan.
3. This approval shall be effective from the date of issuance of the Working Plan.
4. A map of the Division on scale 1:15000, showing the range circles must be annexed.
5. Range wise and Working Circle wise area statement should be submitted in Chapter IX.
6. No forest, bearing naturally grown trees, shall be clear felled.
7. Prior approval of Central Government is needed for carrying out dead, dried, drying and uprooted trees.
8. No trees irrespective of their origin, age, size, and quality shall be cut or removed from forests/plantations of this division, located in the hill regions and/or removed for any purpose whatsoever from any working plan.

The draft Working Plan under consideration, has been examined in accordance with the provisions of the Forests (Conservation) Act, 1980, the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi from time to time; National Forest Policy, 1988; the order of Hon'ble Supreme court in PIL WP (C) No. 202/95 dated 12.12.96 read with WP (C) No. 171/96 and subsequent orders passed in the different IAs by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the National Working Plan Code, 2014.

After careful consideration of the proposal and observations stated above the undersigned is hereby convey the approval of Working Plan of Social Forestry Division, Bijnaur, Uttar Pradesh, for the period 1st October 2019 to 30 September 2029 on following terms and condition:

1. All information provided subsequent to submission of working plan would be treated as part of Working Plan and would be incorporated/annexed in the approved proposal.
2. The Divisional area statement submitted by PCCF, Monitoring & Working Plan, vide letter No. 366/12-5-1-II (Moradabad), dated 21-11-2019, shall be treated as final for the area of this Working Plan.
3. This approval shall be effective from the date of issuance of this letter till the remaining period of the Working Plan.
4. A map of the Division on scale 1:15000, showing the ranges and working circles must be annexed.
5. Range wise and Working Circle wise area statement should be inserted in Chapter IX.
6. No forest, bearing naturally grown trees, shall be clear felled.
7. Prior approval of Central Government is needed for carrying out removal of dead, dried, drying and uprooted trees.
8. No trees irrespective of their origin, age, size, and quality from the forests/plantations of this division located in the hill regions shall be felled and/or removed for any purpose whatsoever from any working circle except


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in accordance with the directions contained in paras (III.1), (III.2), (III.3) and (III.4) of the order dated 12.12.96 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court referred to above. The felling of trees in other areas shall be resorted to as per silvicultural availability and only after a pre-prescribed test check and verification by a gazette officer not below the rank of an Assistant Conservator of Forests. No felling in areas having slope more than 30 and areas vulnerable to erosion/landslides and those having erosion density more than 0.3.

9. No forests/forest land or part thereof shall be leased out or transferred to any Government Department/Organization/Industry etc. for any non-forest purpose in respect of which specific order of re-reservation or diversion of forest land in question were not issued by the State Government of UP prior to 25.10.1980.
10. No forest land or part thereof shall be leased out to anybody for carrying out pre-plantation or plantation activities without prior approval of the Central Govt. under the F(C) Act, 1980 as amended up to date.
11. In Non-Timber Forest Produce (overlapping) working circle proposed collection and disposal of fruits, seeds and other produce having economic significance should be encouraged through the JFMCs rather than other private agencies.
12. The Division in charge should complete list of prospective potential Joint Forest Management areas and workout modalities to ensure grass root level support for protection, development and improvement of forest resources and submit a report on follow up action within two years to this office.
13. Forest areas which have been notified under section 4 of the Indian Forest Act need to be finally settled and notified within the period of two years from the date of this approval.
14. New linear plantations along canal, railway line and road which have not been declared protected forests under Indian Forests Act 1927 need to be notified under relevant provisions of the IFA 1927.
15. All forest areas, which are not managed by the forest department but included within the definition of forest as per the interpretation of Hon'ble Supreme Court will be added to the list of forests mentioned in the working plan and their management should be on the basis of scientific and sustainable forest management.
16. All planting and regeneration operations shall be done either departmentally or through UP Forest Corporation and not through leasing out of areas to any private individual or organization. The species of indigenous nature shall be preferred and mono culture avoided.
17. For cultivation of Tassar and plantation of mulberry for silkworm rearing, to be carried out, in forest land the guidelines of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi under para (1.5) of the consolidated Rules and Guidelines (as amended on 25.10.1992) issued under the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 as referred to above shall be kept in view and complied with in letter and spirit.

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18. Management, conservation and development of the wildlife of the Division shall be carried out as per Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi from time to time as well as through regular consultations with the Chief Wildlife Warden of the State.
19. Collection and/or removal of boulders, stones, baji and sand etc. from the beds of rivulets/nalas from any forest or forest land of the Division shall not be carried out without obtaining prior approval of the Central Govt. under the Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
20. The boundaries of the division shall be demarcated, digitized and maintained properly. Pillars should be inscribed with latitudes and longitudes of the location along with other details. The records of digitization should be updated regularly.
21. Encroachments on forest land shall be got vacated in a time bound programme and area planted up. This work shall be carried out on priority basis and report to this effect shall be submitted to this office.
22. No green tree shall be felled in the name of "petty felling" for any departmental works which shall be met from other felling approved and prescribed in the plan.
23. Grazing shall be regulated as per carrying capacity of forests and no grazing shall be allowed in regeneration areas.
24. Intensive Fire Protection Measure shall be ensured.
25. The pending Compensatory Afforestation (C/A) works of the division pertaining to previous years shall be completed within next two years. Annual progress report of C.A. targets met level against respective projects (in which final approval is accorded for diversion of forest land) should be submitted to this office.
26. Non forest land received should be transferred and mutated in the name of forest department and declared as Reserve Forest in a time bound programme and quarterly report to this effect should be submitted to this office.
27. Construction of new buildings and roads in forest area (if any) will require prior approval from competent authority under Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
28. A mid-term review of the plan shall be carried out.
29. No deviations shall be allowed from the prescriptions of this management plan read with conditions stipulated herein above without prior approval of the Central Government.
30. The working plan prescription have to be followed strictly and the system of annual updating of compartment histories and control forms should be in place.
31. The removal should not exceed the increment normally, except to facilitate natural regeneration.
32. List of Sample plots, preservation plots, seed plots etc. of the division should be annexed with the Working Plan.


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33. The process of Forest Settlement is still not complete in the division. It should be carried out on priority basis and report to this effect shall be submitted to this office.
34. Any change in prescribed silvicultural system, clear felling of natural forest formation or new felling system, large scale felling due to natural calamities which cannot be adjusted against future yield etc., which permanently alter the basis of management laid down in the working plan, will require the sanction of this office.
35. All forest areas which are not covered by the Forest Department but are included within the definition of forests as interpreted by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of 202/95 will be added to the list of forests mentioned in the working scheme.
36. Any amendment in the working plan involving points of technical importance leading to the change in the grasser plan should be sent with necessary amendment to this office by PCCF, (EOPF) through State Government for approval.
37. State Government shall ensure adequate budgetary provision so that the plan prescriptions are implemented timely and effectively.
38. The Central Government reserves the right to review/modify or withhold approval at any point of time depending upon the management needs and other orders of the central government or of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter in future.
