

DETAIL OF PROJECT NOTE

This proposal is for the construction of the link road from Ghyan, Raika via kehral (km 0/0 to 1/945). This area which is still unconnected after 65 year of independence. This road falls under the jurisdiction of B & R sub division Hatkoti under PWD division jubbal and forest division Rohru. The detail of the forest area proposed for diversion are attached in subsequent pages.

This road is an important road as it caters to the neighboring areas of Ghyan, raika, via Kehral. Production of apples and vegetables has increased during the last five years. So Construction of this road is urgently required. With the c/o this motor able road about 500 people of this area will be benefited. The project involves a land of 00-81-46 hect, out of which 00-74-25 hect falls in R/F Naliban, raika & the remaining 00-11-88 hect. Falls in non forest land. (Detail of forest land and non forest land is attached at page no.....)

Cost of the project will be around 49.25 lacs and no adverse effect on the environment is anticipated due to the proposed project. As per the Environment Management plan Muck produced out of the cutting work is to be deposited on the specific dumping place for which a dumping site has been selected in forest land behind the retaining walls etc. HPPWD will be implementing agency for the construction of the road.

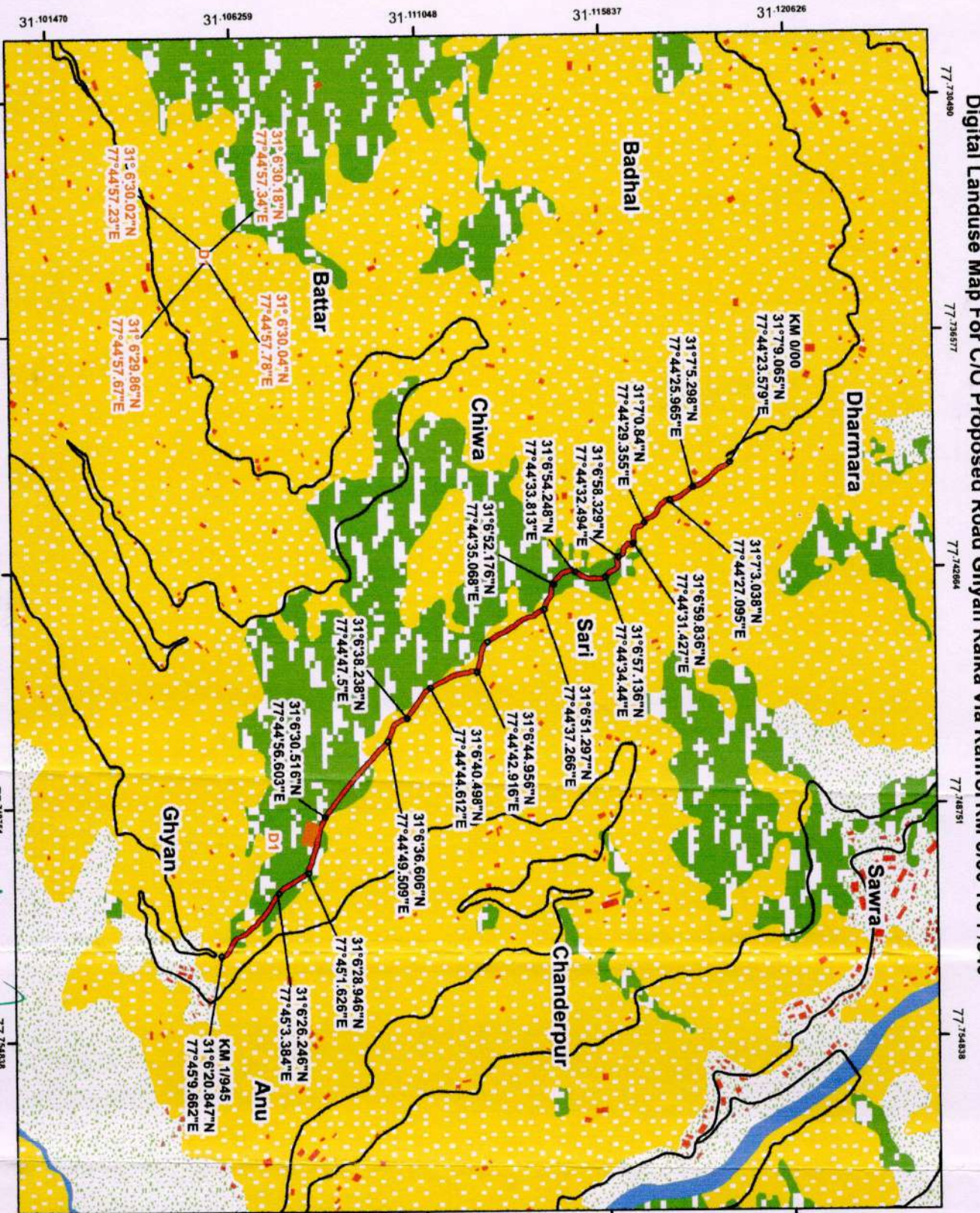

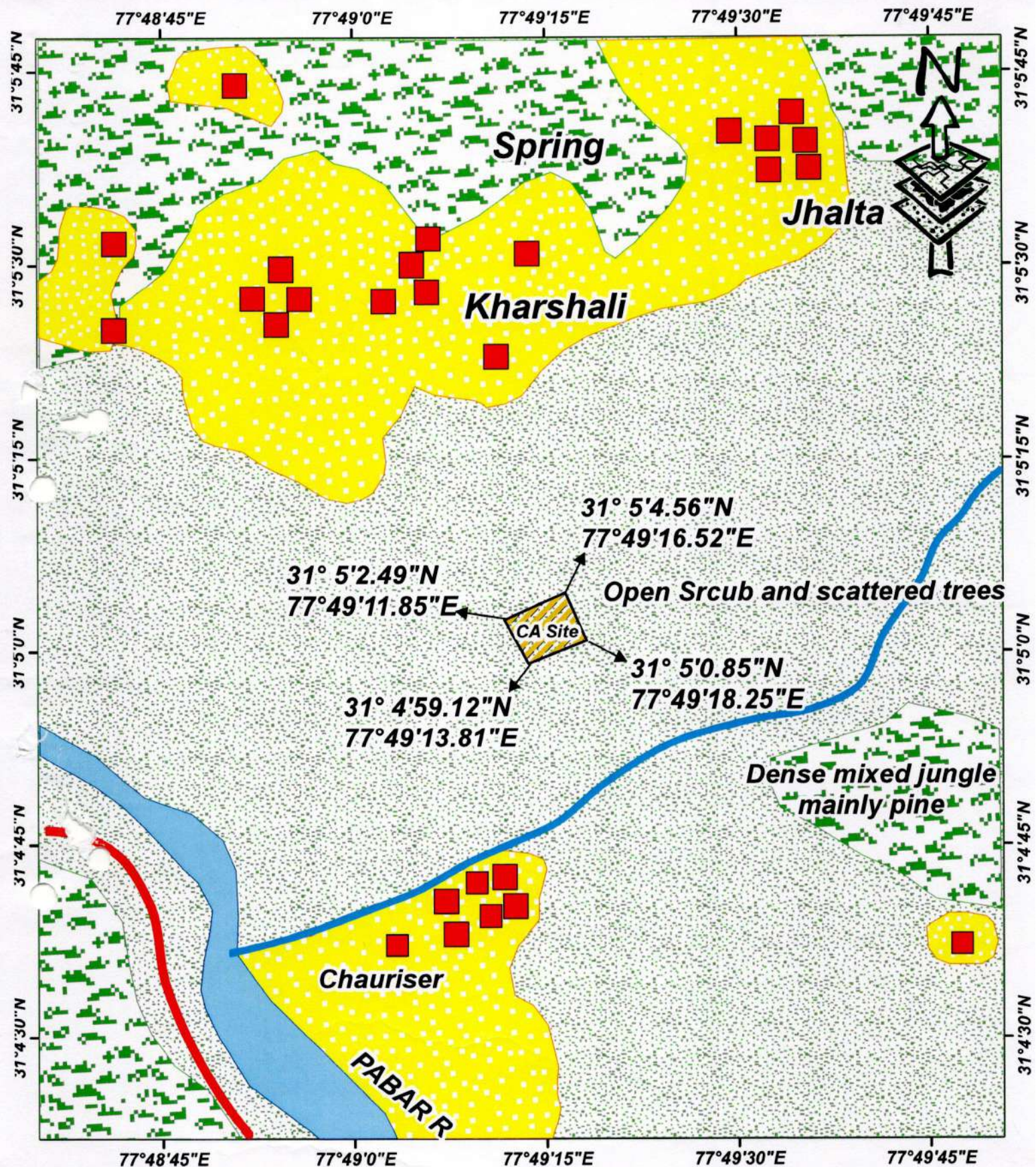

This road falls under Category-II of the above mentioned notification. The width of this road is only 2.75 to 3.5 meter. The geometrics of this road are not as per HP,PWD, standard and require improvement. Total length of the road is 1.945 Kms which includes private as well as Forest land . The detail is as below:-

Population benefites:-

Public Works department has prepared the forest case for this road as this road appear in the budget of the HP,PWD, benefiting around about 250 (Two hundred and fifty) only population directly/indirectly of surrounding panchayat namely GP Kathasu and Dochi . Through local inquiry it was gathered that there existed an old path on this alignment which has been widened by local villagers by pooling up money from private individuals funds, so as to cater to jeepable standard. At present the width of the road is not sufficient as per requirement of PWD standred. This road has neither been taken over nor constructed by the HP, PWD, and this phase has been brought to the notice of the committee by the member secretary/XEN HP,PWD, Jubbal.

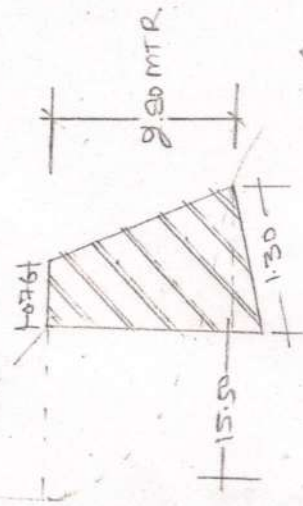
SECTION OF LINK ROAD GUYAN BAIKA VIA KERALAL KM: 11945
