

DETAILED NOTE ON THE PROJECT

The road from Mydukur to Singarayakonda via Porumamilla & C.S.Puram in Andhra Pradesh is recently declared as National Highway by Government of India and assigned National Highway Number NH-167B. Widening of the road from Mydukur to Porumamilla from Km 0/0 to ~~13/007~~ ^{22/300} to two / four lane with paved shoulder under EPC mode is proposed by MoRT&H, Government of India.


NH-167B is the newly converted National Highway. It is the important Highway starting from Mydukur on NH-67 connecting Porumamilla, Seetharampuram, C.S.Puram, Pamuru, Kandukuru and terminating at its junction with NH-16 near Singarayakonda in the state of Andhra Pradesh. It crosses NH-167BG (at Seetharampuram), NH-565 (at Pamuru). This stretch is predominantly known to all because of its agricultural lands and agricultural outputs and having rich mineral resources inspite of all that the stretch is located in the industrial, economically developing area. Widening and improvement of this section of NH-167B would further improve connectivity in terms of achieving smooth and safe traffic flow and improve level of service. In addition to above, substantial economic gain in terms of reduced Vehicle Operating Cost (VOC) and reduced travel time will be

In the above stretch from km 17/900 to 22/300 is passing through Mallepalli beat of Porumamilla range of Proddatur WL Division.

In this above reserve forest only existing road is widened to two lane with paved shoulders. For executing this work land width of 30 mts required. At present width of existing BT Surface is 7 mts.
