PREAMBLE:

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Bangalore vide his letter dated 21/10/2005 read at (1) above has submitted for diversion of 1.00 ha.of forest land in Sy.No.17 of Balale Village for water supply scheme to Gokama and 7 other villages in favour of the Assistant Executive Engineer, IPF Sub-Division, Kumta, Honnavara subject to certain conditions:

The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests, New Delhi vide their letter dated: 3-1-2005 read at (2) above conveyed its general approval under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of land to Government Departments for certain activities.

This proposal has been examined under the General instructions of Government of India in its letter dated: 3.1.2005 and it has been decided to accord sanction for diversion of 1.00 ha. of forest land in Ft. Sy.No. 17 of Balale Village for Water Supply Scheme to Gokama and 7 other Villages. Hence the order.

In the circumstances explained in the preamble and in accordance with the general approval of Government of India in the letter dated 3.1.2005, the Government of Karnataka are pleased to accord approval under section (2) of Forest(Conservation)Act 1980 for diversion of

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1.00 ha.of forest land in Sy.No.17 of Balale Village for water supply schem to Gokama and 7 other villages in favour of the Assistant Executive Engineer, IPF Sub-Division, Kumta, Honnavara subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The legal status of forest land shall continue to be forest land.
- 2. The land should be utilized only for the above purpose for which it is released.
- 3. If the land is not required for the purpose for which it is granted the same should be resumed back to the Forest Department by the Conservator of Forests under Section 82 of Karnataka Forest Act 1963.
- 4. The user ageny has to pay the lease rent as fixed by the Government at the time of sanction and any subsequent orders in this regard.
- 5. The lease is granted for 20 years.
- 6. The Karnataka Forest Act, 1963 and Rules, 1969 will be applicable for any violation.
- 7. If the land is not utilized for the purpose within 2 years, the forest land shall be resumed back by the Conservator of Forests by following the provisions under section 82 of Kamataka Forest Act 1963.
- 8. The user agency shall pay the cost of raising compensatory afforestation over the degraded forest area at the rate prevailing at the time of sanction.
- The user agency has to pay the Net Present Value (NPV) of forest land diverted under this proposal in accordance with Government Notification dated: 17.1.04.
- 10. Trees shall be felled only when it becomes necessary and under strict supervision of State Forest Department
- 11 The user agency shall pay the extraction charges of trees if extraction is necessary, as estimated by the Forest Department.
- 12. The user agency shall ensure that there should be no damage to the available wildlife in the area.
- 13. The project site should be outside National Parks or Wildlife Sanctuary or Protected areas.
- 14. The user agency shall be responsible for any damage/injury to the flora/fauna in surroundings and therefore shall take all possible measures to conserve the same.

16. The State Forest Department/State Government or the concerned Regional Office may impose from time to time any other conditions in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests.

17. Any other conditions to be imposed by the Government of India/Government of Karnataka/Principal Chief Conservator

of Forests, will be abided by the lessee.
