CERTIFICATE REGARDING SUITABILITY OF AREA IDENTIFIED FOR COMPENSATORY AFFORESTATION AND FROM MANAGEMENT POINT OF VIEW

No suitable non-forest land is available for taking up compensatory afforestation for forest area affected by the Diversion of 22.045 ha of Forest Land for Widening/Improvement of existing road Chakpikarong - Sajik - Aigejang (0 km to 19.5 km) to NHSL specifications (Phase-1) in the State of Manipur by 84 RCC (GREF) under Chandel Forest Division, Chandel. As such, suitable degraded forest land has been identified at 1 (One) location under the Division as shown below:

The forest type of these areas falls under Tropical Moist Deciduous Forests. Tree species such as Rhus semialata, Quercus serrata, Alnus nepalensis, Ficus glomerata, Terminalia myriocarpa, Schima wallichii, Cedrela toona, Citrus medica, Syzygium cumini, Castanopsis spp., Bombax ceiba, Ficus benghalensis, Gmelina arborea, Carallia brachiata, Pinus roxburghii etc. and animal species such as Wild Boar, Barking Deer, Python, Squirrel, Jungle Pheasant etc. are found in these areas. As such, tree species namely Gmelina arborea, Terminalia myricarpa, Quercus serrata, Schima wallichii, Cedrela toona etc. will be suited for plantation in the areas.

The identified CA sites can be managed effectively because of their proximity to the villages. Hence, the areas identified are best suited for taking up of Compensatory Afforestation (CA).
