TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest rights) Act' 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted in for non-forest purposes, read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of liner project, it is certified that 0.771 hectare of Revenue forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of BHARATMALA PARIYOJNA Ltd Feeder Canal for MUDPAR in district Bilaspur falls within jurisdiction of for MUDPAR in Masturi Tehsil.

it is further certified that :-

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.771 Hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meeting of the Forest Right Committee (s). Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexureI..... to annexureXII.....
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the projects and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
- c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consents to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of for MUDPAR Village (s) is enclosed as annexureI..... to annexureXII.....
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it.
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded.
