Minutes of meeting held on 02.07.2018 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, MoRTH to discuss the Detailed Project Report (DPR) of 4 laning of Ghazipur Ballia – UP/Bihar section from Km 0.000 to Km 128.000 of NH-19 in the state of Uttar Pradesh.

1. As per the direction given by NHAI, HQ vide letter No. 118167 dated 25/05/2018, a presentation to Secretary, MoRTH was made by the DPR Consultant M/s Aarvee Associates with respect to above cited project. Presentation was made on various issues like advantages of green field alignment vis-à-vis upgrading brown field alignment, present and anticipated traffic volume and other allied issues.

The presentation was concluded with following outcome:

i. To adopt the Green Field Alignment as it is cost effective.

ii. A Spur from the Green Field Alignment at appropriate location would be provided to connect Buxar – Patna stretch of Bihar.

iii. The Carriageway width shall be half width of four lane carriageway excluding the median (as per IRC:SP:84) provided eccentrically i.e. to one side of the acquired land based on the present assessed/ determined volume of traffic.

3. In view of the decision taken as above during the meeting, the consultant M/s Aarvee Associate is directed to go ahead with preparation of the DPR at the earliest.
