Sub: Regarding Issuance of Environment Impact Assessment Clearance in favour of Shri Dipak Rabha for Hatigarh Sand Mahal No.2 under Kamrup West Division, Bamunigaon.

This has reference to your application submitted vide DFO's letter No. MHL/RF/ Hatigarh Sand Mahal No.2/ 4844 dtd. 11/09/2017 along with Form-1M, Google map, G.P.S co-ordinates and other relevant documents seeking environmental clearance for collection of sand from Hatigarh Sand Mahal No.2 near Hatigarh gaon, P.O- Ratanpur, P.S- Chhaygaon of West Kamrup Forest Division, Bamunigaon for collection of sand, under EIA Notification 2006 as well as order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated. 27/02/2012 and also the Office Memorandum of MOEF, Govt. of India, New Delhi dated 18/05/2012.

The quantity collections of stone are as follows:

1. Quantity of stone- 50,000 cum for 5(five) years.
2. Total mining area- 1.0 Ha. subject to obtaining clearance lease/ or settlement for the collection of sand from D.F.O, West Kamrup Division, Bamunigaon.

The extraction of stone will be collected from the area of the GPS Co-ordinates as mentioned below:

The sand shall be collected as per approved mining plan from Hatigarh Sand Mahal No.2 near Hatigarh gaon, P.O- Ratanpur, P.S- Chhaygaon of Kamrup West Division, Bamunigaon.

The proposal has been examined and processed in accordance with EIA Notification 2016 and its amendment thereof. The members of this District Environment Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA) & District Expert Appraisal Committee (DEAC), Kamrup has examined the documents of the proposal for collection of sand. Accordingly, this application has been discussed and scrutinized by both the Committee on 27/6/2017 and found that the project falls under 1(a) and considered as B2 Category of EIA Notification, 2016 and vide O.M of MoEF No. KAA- 58/2016/36/1102-1112 dated, 9th November, 2016. Based on the recommendation of the Committees, the District Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (DEIAA), Kamrup accord Environmental clearance to the project as mentioned above under the provision of EIA compliance of the following specific and general conditions.

I. Specific Condition:-

1. The activity associated with collection of sand shall be done as per approved mining plan. The sand extracted will be supplied for govt. works purpose only.
2. The collection of sand shall not disturb the ground water level at the site.
3. It shall be ensured that collection of sand does not in any way disturb the flow pattern, turbidity and velocity of the stream, river water etc. if any.
4. The collection of sand shall not be carried out within 500 mt of any existing structure such as a bridge, dams, wires, ground water or any other cross drainage structure.
5. The collection activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
6. Measure shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of the collected sand during transportation.
7. Safe guard shall be adopted against health risk on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to collection of sand.
8. Workers/ labours shall be provided with facilities for drinking water & sanitation.
9. Quarrying shall be restricted within the mining permit area along with GPS Co-ordinates as mentioned above.
10. A beam shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having an adequate width.
11. A minimum distance of 15 mtr. from any civil construction shall be kept from the periphery of collection area.
12. No collection of sand shall be allowed within 1 km boundary of National park & wildlife sanctuary.
13. Project proponent shall not fell any standing tree on the land without obtaining prior permission from the Forest Department of their Zone.
14. No forest land shall be disturbed during collection.
15. Proper mitigation measures shall be adopted to avoid contamination of eroded sand/Stone to the river system & cultivated land in any way.
16. The water spray shall be done in the roads to control dust emission while transportation of stone.

17. The vehicle shall not be overloaded and shall be covered with Tarpaulin.
18. The emission from the vehicles shall be maintained within the emission norms and noise level standard.
19. The project proponent shall take necessary measures to ensure that no adverse impacts are caused due collection of stone in the nearby human habitation.
20. A mining of stone will be as per approved mining plan.
21. Conservation measures shall be taken for protection of Flora & Fauna and around mining areas.
22. The Project proponent shall undertake adequate safeguard measures during collection of stone and ensure due to this activity, the hydrological regime of the surrounding area shall not be affected.
23. Collection of stone shall be done in the above mentioned area only.
24. The fauna nesting area shall not be used for mining.
25. This Environmental Clearance is applicable only subject to receipt of mining permit by the project proponent from the Competent Authority as per AMMC Rule, 2013.

II. General Condition:

1. All necessary statutory clearance shall be obtained from competent authority in connection with mining operation and copies of the same shall be submitted to DEIAA, Kamrup.
2. No Wildlife habitat will be infringed.
3. The Project proponent shall comply the provisions framed under Assam Minor Mineral Concession Rule, 2013.
4. First Aid facilities shall be provided at site.
5. The DEIAA Kamrup may alter/modify the above conditions or stipulate any further condition in the interest of environment protection.
6. The DEIAA, Kamrup may revoke or suspend the order, if any violation of the terms & conditions in the specific and general condition are noticed.
7. Concealing the facts or failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned above may result in withdrawal of this clearance and attract action under the provisions of Environment Protection Act, 1986.
8. The Environmental Clearance is valid for a period of 1(one) year from the date of issue of this order.
9. User agency shall comply the provision framed under Assam Minor Mineral Concession Rule, 2013.
10. The above conditions will be enforced inter-alia the provision of water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 the environment Protection Act, 1986 and the public liability insurance Act, 1991 along with their amendments & rules.
11. The project proponent shall submit half yearly compliance reports in respect of the terms & conditions stipulated in this order to the DEIAA, Kamrup.
12. The Divisional Forest Officer, West Kamrup Forest Division, Bamunigaon shall realize Royalty and other admissible taxes as per existing rate.
