

Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Visakhapatnam on the proposed diversion of forestland (0.5560 ha) for laying of Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along the road within the existing Right of way passing through Ananthagiri RF-II of Visakhapatnam division in favour of Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited, Visakhapatnam on 04-11-2016

Inspected the proposed land for laying of Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along the road within the existing Right of way passing through Ananthagiri RF-II along with Forest Section Officer and Officials of Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited, Visakhapatnam. The proposed OFC path width is 0.400 m and length 13,900 m and is passing through Ananthagiri RF-II Compartment Nos. 495, 491, 488, 489, 481, 480 and 470 for an area of 0.5560 ha. There are no trees falling along the length and width of proposed OFC path. The density of the forests on the proposed width of the ~~part~~ is less than 0.10 density.



This project is very useful for many remote villages. This project is very essential for all departments to extend the Government activities to all the tribals to bring them in the main stream. There is no violation of work taken place and the required forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of flora and fauna and no protected archeological importance in this locality.
