

JOINT INSPECTION REPORT

The site proposed for diversion of 5.2187 Ha. Forest land for Construction of underground station at Krishna Park and elevated corridor between Keshopur to Murkarba Chowk for Janakpuri to RK Ashram Corridor of MRTS phase-IV in the state of NCT of Delhi by DMRC, was inspected along with DMRC officials on 11.01.2021.

DMRC has proposed/enumerated 1230 No. of trees for felling, however, during the site inspection it has been observed that some trees may attain girth of 15.7 cm and if any trees which are inadvertently not enumerated, then for that DMRC has given an undertaking to submit the list of these extra trees before applying for stage-II approval and these trees will only be cut after due verification by Forest Department. Total Forest area proposed for diversion is 5.2187 Ha. under North Forest Division. The Forest area consists of Plantation along Railway tracks, road side plantation along with existing road and patches of naturally grown trees on the developed area of road. Construction activity will be done mainly within RoW. This area comes under the category of Forest and Deemed Forest as per norms decided by Govt. of NCT of Delhi as per the WP(C) No. 202 of 1995 in the Hon'ble Supreme Court, in the matter of T.N.Godhavarman Thirumulkpad Vs. Union of India & Others. The Proposal involves removal of 1230 no. of trees.
