In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 [as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014; Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014; and Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2016] it is certified that 3.96 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **Sri Y. Mahendranath Reddy for grant of quarry lease for Road metal over an extent of 3.96 Ha falling in compartment no.313 of Gulamaliabad South RF, Dhone Range, Kurnool Forest Division** in the district falls within the jurisdiction of **Banaganapalli (V & M) of Kurnool District**. It is further certified that:

- (c) each of the concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. Copies of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha(s) of **Banaganapalli (V&M)** villages(s) are enclosed as attachment;
- (d) the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50 % of the members of Gram Sabhas present;
- (e) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (f) the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per Section 3 (1) of the FRA, 2006.

The proposed area for diversion in Compt.No.313 of Gulam Aliabad South Block R.F, Kurnool Division does not fall in the Scheduled Tribes area and therefore does not attract the provisions of RoFR Act, 2006. Consequent on which, identification and settlement of rights under FRA does not arise.


