Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to the aforesaid sub-section and by sub-section (1) of the said section, read with section 80-A of the aforesaid Act, the Governor of Uttar Pradesh is pleased to declare that pending such enquiry and record the provisions of Chapter IV of the said Act to be applicable to the land specified in the schedule hereunder.

XVI of 1937), will occupy such length of time as in the meantime to endanger the rights of the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the sub-section(1) of the said section, read with section 80-A of the aforesaid Act, he is pleased to declare that pending such inquiry and record, the provisions of Chapter IV of the said Act shall be applicable to the lands specified in the Schedule hereto :
