ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR

NOTIFICATION

Dated Dispur, the 5th March, 1999.

NO.FR.W. 21/90/171 :- In exercise of the powers conferred vide Section 35 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and the Wildlife (Protection) Amendment Act, 1991, the Governor of Assam is pleased to declare the area described in schedule below to be a National Park with effect from the date of publication of the Notification in the official Gazette.

- SCHEDULE -

A. LOCATION .

District (Civil)	:	Tinsukia and Dibrugarh.
Sub-Division (Civil)	:	Dibrugarh, Tinsukia, Sadiya.
Name of Forest Division	:	Tinsukia Wildlife Division, Tinsukia,
Name of National Park	:	Dibru-Saikhowa National Park.
Area	:	340 Sq.Kms.

B. Boundary Descriptions.

East :- Starting from 0 Mile post at Dholia Hatighuli Dyke on the NH. 37 (which can be located by running a line at bearing of $23^{\circ} - 38'$ for a distance of 1640 metres from Railway Bridge on the Dholia river, to meet at Dholia, Hatighuli Dyke and thence measuring along the Dyke at a bearing of 107° for a distance of 480 metres) along NH. 37 towards Saikhowaghat at a bearing of 16° for a distance of 670 metres upto the left bank of Bandarkhal Nallah. Then along left bank of Bandarkhal upto the confluence of Bandarkhal with the Lohit river.

North :- From the confluence point of Bandarkhal with the Brahmaputra then towards West along the South bank of the Brahmaputra upto the old Laikaghat, thence along the South bank of Brahmaputra towards downstream which is the original Dibru-Reserve Forest boundary upto the meeting point of Chabrujan.

West :- From the juncture point of Chabrujan along downstream of the Brahmaputra upto the confluence of Dibru - river.

-: 2 :-

From the confluence of Dibru-river in the upstream along right bank upto the confluence of Chebrujan with Dibru-river (the Western end point of original Dibru-river). Then runs upstream of Dibru-river along right bank upto Khamtigowalighat (upto this point, the Western part of the Dibru-Saikhwa Wildlife Sanctuary falls under jurisdiction of Dibrugarh Civil District) and then along the Southern boundary of the original Dibru-Reserve Forest where it meets the Southern boundary of the Saikhwa-Reserve Forest on Azukha Nallah. Thence along the Southern boundary of Saikhwa Reserve Forest towards east to a point near Hatighuli Beat. Thence along the Southern boundary of the Saikhwa Reserve Forest towards east to a point at a bearing of 30° - for a distance of 1,760 metres to meet the Dholla-Hatighuli Dyke. Then along the said Dyke which runs at a bearing of 121° for 420 metres 122° for 280 metres, 177° for 920 metres, 100° for 1060 metres 145° for 1260 metres 111° for 800 metres, 84° for 440 metres 81° for 220 metres 90° for 300 metres, 93° for 100 metres, 52° for 400 metres 69° for 700 metres, 93° for 80 metres 106° for 140 metres, 107° for 480 metres and meet the starting point.
