

This is with reference to the EDS raised by your department on the subject cited above. In this context this is to inform you that the shortcomings have been attended as below:-

1	Against column No. A I. (vii), the estimated cost of the project has been mentioned as Rs. 284.87 Lacs whereas against column No. I (iii) cost of the project has been mentioned as Rs. 284.87 crore. Further, in detail note, cost of the project has been mentioned as Rs. 270.70 crore including 1.5 % LADF and IDC of Rs. 22.78 crore.	The estimated cost of proposed 2 x 21 MW (42 MW) Baggi Hydro Electric Power Project is Rs. 284.87 Crore. The Detail of cost abstract of Baggi HEP has been enclosed as Annexure.
2	Total financial layout for CA has not been mentioned in Part-II of the proposal folders at P.NO. 12. Further, financial layout for CA, Rs. 3,62,296/- has been mentioned against column No. 13 (i) of online Part-II, whereas total financial layout for CA has been mentioned as Rs. 3,62,969/- in CA scheme at page No. 52 of the proposal folder.	Pertains to DFO
3	Muck Management Plan has been placed at Page No. 58 but the cost of engineering work and plantation work for rehabilitation of dumping sites.	Muck generated will be dumped in open site which is suitable for Dumping. The proposed open space is a non-forest land which is already under the ownership of BBMB and after dumping the said space can be used to store old machinery. There is no need of forest land for dumping site.
4	It may also be informed whether the dumping sites as proposed are in forest land and the land proposed for dumping sites have been included in the total land proposed for diversion. If the dumping site are proposed in forest land and the same may also be shown in the digital map of the project sites and may also be shown in the component wise breakup against column no. B 2.4 of part-I	The proposed dumping site is not in the forest land and the Muck will be dumped in the existing land already in the premises of BBMB and there is no need of submitting certificate for the same.
