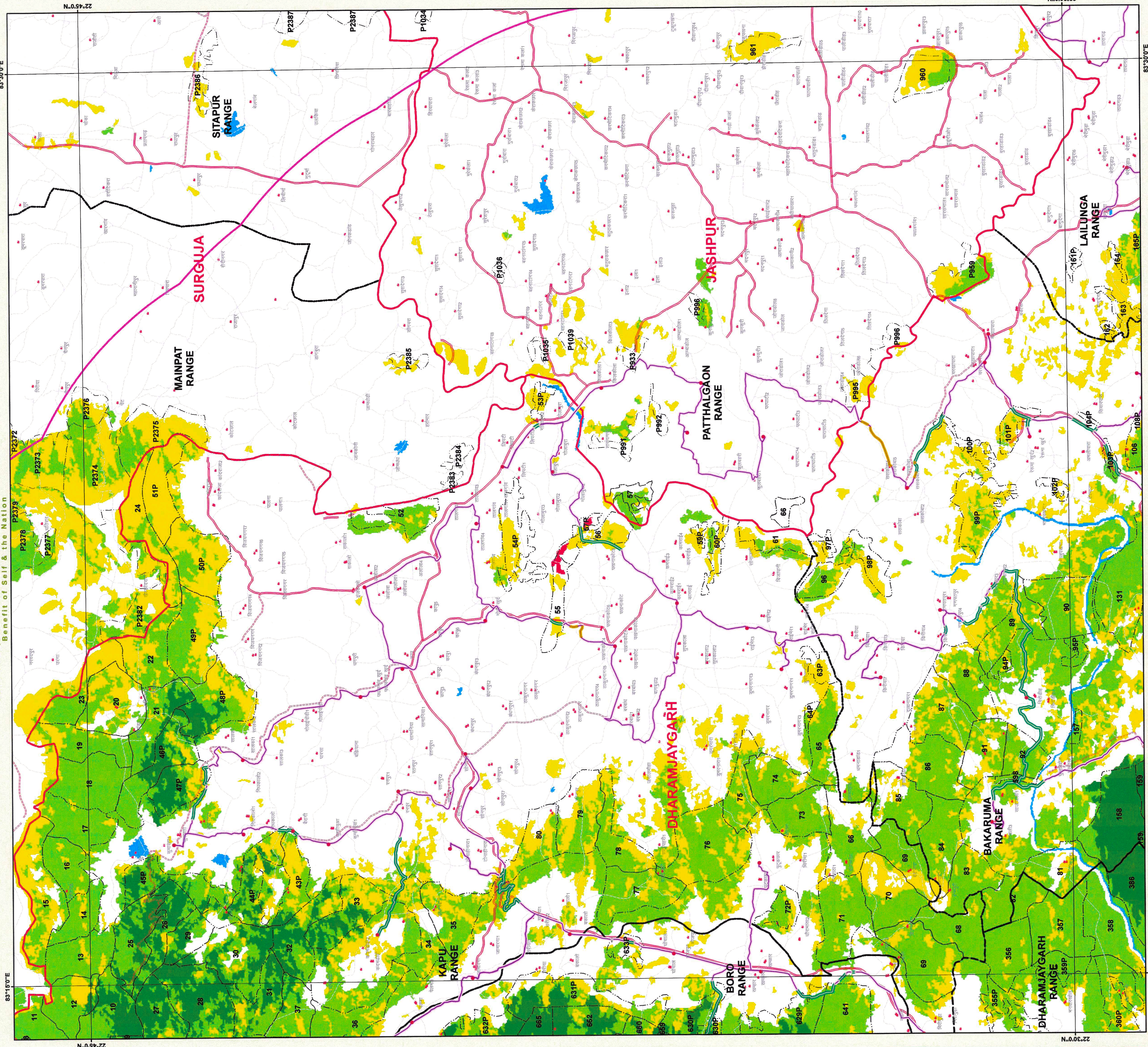

Very Dense forest - All land with tree canopy density more than 70% and above
 Dense forest - All land with tree canopy density between 60% and 70% above
 Moderately Dense forest - All land with tree cover (including Mangrove Cover) of canopy density between 40% and 60% above
 Open Forest - All land with tree cover (including Mangrove Cover) of canopy density between 10-40% above
 Scrub - All forest lands with poor tree growth mainly of small or stunted trees having canopy density less than 10%
 Non Forest - Any Area not included in the above classes.
