

The forest patches proposed by user agency for expansion is in industrial zone only and suitable for expansion as these are contiguous to the existing units and thus site specific. 2. Further these are isolated patches of small areas which is not suitable from management point of view. 3. 2.41 ha area of total area of 6.44 ha in gut number 18 has already been encroached by well-established basti known Indira Nagar Basti. 4. The major area proposed for diversion falls in industrial zone of Nagpur Development Plan.
