Payment of NPV has been made for Rs. 7,93,26,720 as advance as per MoEF circular dated 01.04.2015 considering density of 0.3. Tree enumeration has been completed and there are 4418 trees of different species. Felling of these trees will be required. Three copies of the enumeration list has been submitted to the Range Officer (Burmu Range) for further necessary action vide letter no. 106 dated 17.10.2017. Copy attached as Annexure – I.
