By Gazette Notification No. 3208/XIV dated 23.8.1955, the land specified in the schedule below have been declared as protected forests under chapter IV of the Indian Forest Act, hence provisions of the Indian Forest Act shall now be applicable to the road side plantations as well.

Therefore, henceforth cases of offences committed in the road side plantations should be regarded as 'Forest Offences' punishable under the I.F.A. or under any rule made thereunder, and should be dealt with as such. Accordingly the cases of forest offence may be sent to a court of law for prosecution or may be got compounded by the Divisional Forest Officer under section 68 of the I.F.A.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 32 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Act No. XVI of 1927), the Governor is pleased to make the following rules for the protected forests declared as such by Govern- ment notification no. 3208/XIV, dated August 23, 1955.

RULES:

No person shall, without the permission of a Forest Officer, do, attempt to do, or cause to be done, any of the following acts:

- (1) The cutting, sawing, conversion and removal of any tree and the ~~ripping~~ collection, manufacture and removal of forest produce from the protected forests;
- (2) The clearing and breaking of land for cultivation of or for making of any threshing floor (Khalian) or tethering cattle, erecting of any temporary or permanent hut or house in such forests;
- (3) The cutting of grass and pasturing of cattle in such forests; and
- (4) The lighting, kindling or burning of any fire near such forests.
