Sub- Proposal for diversion of 30.630 ha, of forest land for construction of Kala Barrage Project in Deogarh and Bonai Forest Division.

Sir,

In inviting a kind reference to the letter on the subject cited above, the point wise compliance/clarification to the EDS made by your office is submitted herewith for kind information and necessary action.

Observation-1

Index has not been furnished in the DP.

Compliance:

Index is enclosed in the diversion proposal at Page No. I to II.

Observation-2

The status of the total land (both forest and non-forest) involved in the project as on 25.10.1980 has not been furnished. The land schedule should be certified by the Tahasildar concerned in the manner as suggested vide circular No. R&DM-GE(GL)-S- 63/13-4822/CS Dtd.12.02.2015 of the Chief Secretary, Odisha which has been communicated to all RCCFS/all DFOS vide Memo No.4431/F&E Dtd.16.03.2015 (Copy enclosed) of F&E Department, Govt. of Odisha. Further, on verification of RoRs of the plots of the Non-Forest land furnished in the DP with the "Bhulekh" (the Land Records Web Portal of Odisha), it is seen that out of 182 nos. of plots shown as non-forest, under the remarks column of more than 55 nos. of plots, it has been mentioned as "SabikKissam Bad Jungle" or "Jungle". Since the RoRs of the said plots are published after 25.10.1980, the status of those plots as on 25.10.1980 could be forest. You are, therefore, requested to ascertain the status of those plots as on 25.10.1980 from the Tahasildar concerned. In case the status of those plots is found to be forest as on 25.10.1980, the forest land proposed for diversion may increase and, in that case, the diversion proposal needs to be revised.

Compliance:

Land Schedule has been updated and certified by the Tahasildar, Barkote and diversion proposal is revised according to the new area.

Observation-3

Tree enumeration list in respect of the non-forest land involved in the project has not been furnished. It should be furnished with the number of trees required to be felled from the non-forest land.

Compliance:

Tree enumeration list in respect of the non-forest land involved in the project has been enclosed in the diversion proposal at Page No. 201 to 204, with the number of trees required to be felled from the non-forest land.

Observation-4

The Catchment area treatment plan is found to have been prepared at the wage rate of Rs.224.30 per man day. The financial outlay of the plan should be recast at the current wage rate i.e. Rs.286.30 per man day.

Compliance:

The Catchment area treatment plan is now prepared at the current wage rate of Rs. 298.00 per man day and enclosed in the diversion proposal at Page No. 242 to 282.

According to the EDS, the compliance has been made and the diversion proposal in 6 set is resubmitted herewith for processing and onwards transmission of the Forest Diversion Proposal of Kala Barrage Project.
