The letter has been uploaded on the portal at Sr. No. 43, titled "DoE Letter."</p> <p>With reference to the point no. 18(ii), it is respectfully submitted that in compliance with the MoEF&CC, Government of India guidelines dated 07.06.2022, a detailed Soil and Moisture Conservation Plan (SMCP) & Wild Life Management Plan (WLMP) is being prepared separately, focusing specifically on the forest and proposed for diversion. The plan includes site-specific mitigation measures to address soil erosion, slop stabilization, and prevention of landslides during and after the execution of the project. The cost of implementation of the SMCP & WLMP has also been calculated and will be deposited in the Ad-hoc CAMPA as per the prescribed procedure.</p>
