The District Level Committee Meeting on implementation of Scheduled tribes & Other traditional forest dwellers (recognition of forest rights) Act, 2006 and Rule 2007 was held on 9.11.2017 at 04:00PM in Collector's Conference hall, Koraput under the Chairmanship of Collector, Koraput. At the outset the Project Administrator, I.T.D.A., Koraput welcomed all the members present and requested Collector, Koraput to preside over the meeting. The Project Administrator, I.T.D.A., Koraput placed before the committee 245 nos. of individual claims duly approved and recommended by SDLC Jeypore vide letter no.5664, dt. 16.10.2017 and letter no. 4906, dt.5.9.17 for approval at DLC Koraput. On scrutiny of the applications it is found that out of 245 nos. of individual claims received from SDLC Jeypore, 237 nos. are valid in all respects and unanimously approved at DLC. The remaining 08 nos. of claims from SDLC Jeypore have been decided to remand due to improper joint verification report and insufficient documents like Identity proof, age proof etc.

#### RECOGNITION OF COMMUNITY RIGHTS AND COMMUNITY FOREST RESOURCES RIGHTS.

633 nos. of Community Rights (Form-B = 475nos. and Form-C = 158) claims were received by the Forest Rights Committee. These claims are pending at different level in the respective Gram Sabha. The WEOs were instructed to take follow up action and submit the claims to the respective SDLC after approval of the Gram Sabha.

( Action to be taken : All Welfare Extension Officers)

#### DIVERSION OF FOREST LAND FOR NON-FOREST PURPOSE

The project Administrator, I.T.D.A., Koraput informed the DLC that 02 nos. of claims have been received for diversion of forest land for non-forest purpose. 01 no. of proposal has been received from the Executive Engineer NH Division, Jeypore covering 2.892 Ha relating to widening of Ranchi Vijayawada -Corridor. And 01nos. of proposal has been received from the Director, Meenakshi Odisha Power (P) Limited, (Formerly Sileru Power Generation (P) Limited, Tentuligumma under Boipariguda

Tahsil for setting up of 25MW small Hydro Electricity Project. All the proposals have been duly recommended by the concerned FRC, Grama Sabha, SDLC- Jeypore and certified by the concerned DFOs.

The project Administrator, I.T.D.A., Koraput informed that the proposal of the Executive Engineer NH Division, Jeypore was approved in the last DLC held on 26.05.2017 and the clearance certificate was also issued with the signature of the Collector-cum-Chairman DLC Koraput. But the proposal was not approved in the SDCL Jeypore prior to the previous DLC meeting. The proposal received from SDLC Jeypore has been discussed and approved and to be kept at DLC for official records in future.

Further, the proposal has been received from the **Director, Meenakshi Odisha Power (P) Limited, (Formerly Sileru Power Generation (P) Limited** for setting up of 25MW small Hydro Electricity Project. For this the certificate had already been issued by the then Collector Koraput & Chairman DLC vide letter no. 444, dt. 18.02.2012 of Collectorate Koraput (Revenue Section). But the certificate issued by the Collector earlier was without having the proceedings of the SDLC and DLC. Now the same agency has applied with the proceedings of FRC, Grama Sabha and SDLC-Jeypore duly recommended by D.F.O, Malkangiri. The committee found that the 2nos of proposals received are genuine and unanimously approved for diversion of forest land for non forest purpose.

## DEMARCATIION AND IDENTIFICATION OF RECOGNIZED LAND OF THE BENEFICIARIES ALREADY SETTLED WITH THE USE OF SPACE TECHNOLOGY.

The Project Administrator, I.T.D.A Koraput informed the DLC that as per letter no. 17784, dt. 11.10.2017 of ST & SC Development Department it is instructed to use Space Technology to determine the rights of tribal communities under Forest Right Act, 2006. The same has also been communicated to Sub-Collector, Koraput / Jeypore and DFO, Koraput / Jeypore, all Tahasildars and WEOs vide office letter no. 3534, dt. 31.10.2017. The main emphasis of the letter includes the following actionable points.


1. Use of technology for creation of geo-referenced database on vesting of rights/correction of record rights.
2. Awareness among tribal community and OTFDs for generating fresh claims of those individuals and Gram-Sabhas who have not even applied for their rights (individuals, community and community forest resource rights). Fresh Gram Sabha meeting need to be convened.
3. Sou-motto review of rejected claims.
4. Early disposal of all pending claims.

Hence the Sub-Collector, Koraput/Jeypore, D.F.O., Koraput / Jeypore and all Tahasildars were instructed to take up the follow up action as per the instruction of Govt. and submit the monthly progress report in this regard.

## CORRECTION OF ROR AND MAPs

The Project Administrator, I.T.D.A Koraput brought to the notice of the committee that 28,191 nos. of individual titles (Koraput Sub-Division-20,813 and Jeypore Sub-Division-7,378) have been distributed to the beneficiaries and 58 nos. of Community titles (Koraput Sub-Division-45 and Jeypore Sub-Division-13) have been distributed to tribal community. The Collector-cum-Chairman DLC



instructed all the Inanasiidars and DFOs to take expeditious steps for correction of RoRs and Maps. The progress on correction of ROR and Maps as detailed below:






### CONVERSION OF FOREST VILLAGE INTO REVENUE VILLAGE

The Project Administrator, ITDA Koraput brought to the notice of the committee that , the Govt. in Revenue & Disaster Management Deptt., and ST & SC Development Department have issued instructions from time to time for conversion of forest village, un-surveyed village and old habitation etc. into revenue villages under section 3(1)(h). In this regard the circulars of Govt. have also been communicated to all concern for necessary follow up action for conversion of forest villages, un-surveyed village and old habitation etc. into revenue villages. But till date no such steps have been taken-up by D.F.O., Koraput / Jeypore, Sub-Collector, Koraput / Jeypore and Tahasildars of this district. In the last DLC Sub-Collectors Koraput/ Jeypore were requested to review the matter regularly but no such report have been received. Hence the Collector once again instructed to take immediate follow up action in this matter. There are 83 nos. of such villages to be converted to revenue village and the details list of forest village of concerned blocks had already been communicated in last DLC, which is ~~place~~ below.

#### ENGAGEMENT OF RETIRED. REVENUE INSPECTOR / AMIN /DATA ENTRY OPERATOR UNDER FOREST RIGHTS ACT, 2006.


The PA, ITDA Koraput informed the committee that, the advertisement regarding engagement of Retd. Revenue Inspector / Amin has already been published vide office no. 3377, dt. 17.10.2017 to engage for FRA work in all the Tahasils and D.F.O Office. But till date no applications have been received. It was mentioned that Govt. in SSD vide letter no. 39223/SSD dt. 11.11.2008 have issued clarification for hiring of technical persons like Retd. R.Is and Amins @ 3500/- per month by Revenue and Forest Department Officials. But no such technical person are interested to work on the said remuneration.


TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 4.902 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of the Director, Meenakshi Odisha Power (P) Limited, ( Formerly Sileru Power Generation(P) Limited, Tentuligumma under Boipariguda Tahsil, for setting up of 25 MW Saheed Lakhan Nayak Small Hydro Electric Project near Tentuligumma village on river Kolab Koraput District falls within jurisdiction of Khata No. 72, Plot no. 21, 23,24,25,26,422,783 & 784 of Tentuligumma Village in Block /Tahasil : Boipariguda, Dist. Koraput.

It is further certified that:

1. The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 4.902 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee Gram Sabha, Sub-Divisional Level Committee and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure A, B & C.
2. The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular / local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
3. The each of concerned Gram Sabha has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Tentuligumma village is enclosed as annexure A.
4. The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
5. The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it.
6. The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of the FRA.
