SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF
(For the Forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from, Executive Engineer, PWD B&R, Sangrur for diversion (under FCA-1980) for non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land diversion of 0.700 ha of forest land in favour of Executive Engineer Provl Division, PWD B&R sangrur for widening & strengthening of Sangrur-Elwal Road up to National Highway bypass 0-2 B/s, under Forest Division & Distt-Sangrur. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 5/2/2020

2. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected Forest land measuring 0.700 hec

3. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of Part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.

4. Weather any rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area if so the details thereof.

5. Weather any protected archaeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area, if so, the details thereof with NOC from the competent authority.


6(a) The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction.

6(b) It has been found that the user agency has violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Indian Forest Act 1927 detailed on violation of provisions at Indian Act is attached.
