A proposal has been received by this office from BSNL Rajkot, for diversion (under FCA) of 1.0719 Hectares of the forest land for non forestry purpose i.e. for laying of optical fibre cable, in the state of Gujarat. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on

On inspection of the site it is found that the land required by the user agency is in protected forest admeasuring 1.0719 Hectares.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col 2 of part-I is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project.

No protected, archeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monuments located in the area.

No rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area. It is recommended to divert this land for the purpose.
