SITE INSPECTION REPORT

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received in this office from M/S Shayam Kumar r/o village Tikkari, PO Panjgain, Tehsil Sadar, Distt. Bilaspur, HP for diversion (Under FCA 1980) of 8.1683 Ha. of forest land for Non forestry purpose of Bilaspur Forest Division. The project envisages the use of forest land for diversion of 8.1683 ha. of forest land for collection/extraction of sand, stone and bajri within the Jurisdiction of Bilaspur Forest Division, Distt. Bilaspur, HP. I have done the site inspection of the land involved in the proposal on dated 10.02.2021.

During inspection of the area it has been found that the forest land proposed for the above purpose by the User Agency is 8.1683 Ha. (Zamabandi & Maps attached) which is duly demarcated by Forest as well as revenue authority.

The requirement of land as proposed by the User Agency in column 2 of Part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the purpose.
