A proposal has been received by this office from **PMGSY Division Kishtwar** for the diversion (under FCA-1980) of 2.895 Ha. of forest for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Construction of road from Patnazi to Kither. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 31-1-2021.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 2.895 ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 of part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.


