Specific recommendation of concerned Conservator of Forests for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with detailed reasons.

Almost the entire area had moderate slope with some portion being gently sloping. At places, the soil erosion was easily seen. The proposed area towards Tori - Shivpur line has seen significant wildlife presence. During the site visit, it was told by the local villagers and the staffs that elephants from Palamu and Hazaribagh side cris crosses 2-3 times in a year. The nature of the project is such that there is going to be habitat fragmentation and destruction. For the facts stated above the proposed diversion is recommended to be accepted with following conditions :-

- 1 Site specific Wildlife Management Plan to be prepared in consultation with Forest Department to mitigate the impacts on wildlife and its habitat.
- Soil and moisture conservation plan will be needed to address soil erosion. 2.
