Proposal for diversion of 17.02 ha of forest land for setting up 4000 MW Ultra, Mega Power Project near Bhedabahal, Sundargarh district of M/s Orissa Integrated Power Limited.

With reference to the proposal cited above, I submit herewith the proposal for diversion of 17.02 ha of forest land for setting up 4000 MW Ultra, Mega Power Project, Sundargarh district of M/s Orissa Integrated Power Limited in Six copies for obtaining approval of Central Government of India under Section-2 of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 pertaining to Sundargarh Forest Division.

1. Brief Description:

With an aim to achieve power for all and considering the high growth rate of economy the Government of India has envisaged capacity addition. Accordingly, Ministry of Power, Government of India has initiated the scheme for development of Ultra Mega Power Project in India at pit head and Coastal sides to overcome acute power shortage in the country. The objective is to develop large capacity power projects in India and attract potential investors including private participation for development of such projects. To meet this objective Power Finance Corporation (PFC) has been identified as nodal agency for developing these Ultra Mega Power Projects (UMPP's) through Special Purpose Vehicles (SPV's) under the technical guidance of Central Electricity Authority (CEA). These SPV's would be transferred to the developers who will be selected through the tariff based international competitive bidding. These SPV's shall be taking all the necessary initials actions such as obtaining environmental clearances, linkages for water and coal including allocation of coal blocks/ mines, initiating land acquisition process, carrying out various technical studies for preparation DPR etc. for the project.

Government of Odisha conveyed its support for the developments of UMPP in Odisha in providing necessary assistance to Government of India vide the letter of Chief Secretary, Govt. of Odisha dated 14th March' 2007.

Accordingly, Orissa Integrated Power Limited (OIPL) an SPV of Power Finance Corporation (PFC), Government of India got the administrative approval of CEA, Government of India for getting all statutory clearances for establishment of project.

CEA, PFC and State Government selected the site on the western side of the SH -10 (between IB river and SH – 10) near Bedabahal village for setting up of UMPP. MoEF has also visited the site. On the basis report of Sub Committee and presentation made to the Expert Appraisal Committee, ToR was issued for the proposed plant. Subsequently EAC recommended the proposal for the power project for environmental clearance on 13.02.2014.

The proposal for setting up of the project was approved in the Gram Sabhas held in January, 2010 subject to the condition that the entire area of three villages namely Kopasinga, Rupidihi

and Lankahuda, along with all habitations, and also including the area adjoining the IB river is to be acquired. A letter, communicating this condition, was received from Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Govt. of Odisha on February 19, 2010. The conditions were accepted by OIPL. Govt. of Odisha has accorded the administrative approval for acquisition of private land for Ultra Mega Power Project (UMPP) in Sundargarh district for six villages.

The total land required for the project is 2459.998 acres (995.547 Ha) for the main plant including ash dyke and the colony. However, a total of 3218.10 acres (1302.35 Ha) of land is being acquired honoring the decision of Gram sabha resolution.

The proposal is for diversion of 42.05 acres (17.02 Ha) of revenue forest land within the project area of 2459.998 acres (995.547 Ha).

Mammals like Indian Hare, Wild Pig, Jackel, Jungle Cat, Barking Dear, Monkey, Elephants are seen during paddy harvesting season occasionally and snakes are available in general. Total 575 nos. of trees have been enumerated in the forest land within the project area.

The proposed area does not form a part of national park, wild life sanctuary, biosphere reserve, tiger reserve etc.

5. Trees enumeration:

Plot wise enumeration has been carried out in the Forest area applied for diversion. The details enumeration list has been enclosed separately with the proposal as per checklist Sl No.19.

6. Compensatory Afforestation

Compensatory afforestation land has been identified in Sundargarh District. Compensatory afforestation scheme as prepared has been approved by user agency is enclosed as per checklist SI No. 22
